

Saturday May 21st
Commences with light winds at 8 E. steering N.E. the ice and several Ships in sight, Middle and Latter part light hailing airs and Calm. Nothing in sight but Ships and ice.

Sunday May 22nd
Commences with light winds and Calm 11 Ships in sight, at 6 30 spoke Ship Electra of New London for Whale middle hailing, Latter part strong winds at 8 Ship standing on Opposit tack to clear the ice 18 Ships in sight.

Monday May 23rd
Commences with strong winds at 8 E. Ship on Opposit tack. Middle part strong gales by accompanied with snow and rain. Latter part Calm with thick fog most of the time saw Nothing but Ships and the ice. No Obs.

Tuesday May 24th
Commences with light winds and Calm with fog squalls. spoke Ship Conthron Nothing this season middle part hailing. Latter part light winds at 8 E. Ship heading N.E. threw feed ice, 22 Ships in sight but no Whales.

Wednesday May 25th
Commences with light winds at 8 E. steering N.E. threw feed ice, Middle part lag by in the ice Latter part light winds at 8, working through ice saw the Boat off Cape Thudens Dist 35 Miles ice packed solid between the Ship and land, spoke Ship Delaurye. Nothing. No Obs.

Thursday May 26th
Commences with light winds at 8. Ship in the ice 18 Ships in sight. Also the Land saw 2 small Whales spoke Ship Roman Comiskey Nothing. Middle and Latter part light winds at 8. Ship on Opposit docks in the ice. 32 Ships in sight.

Friday May 27th
Commences with light winds at N.E. Ship close to the pack ice Cape Thudens in sight Dist 15 Miles. 32 Ships in sight, Middle and Latter part fresh winds from N.E. accompanied with thick snow squalls Ship standing on Opposit tacks in the ice under short sail, saw several small Whales. No Obs. Lat by account 61.40. N. Long 181.35. W

Saturday May 28th
Commences with strong winds at N.E. Ship in the ice. Nothing in sight, it being thick most of the time, Middle and Latter part strong gales from N.E. Ship standing on Opposit tacks in the ice 25 Ships in sight. Lat by Obs 61.49. N. Long 181.30. W

Sunday May 29th
Commences with strong gales at N.E. Ship in the ice Cape Thudens in sight Dist 30 Miles, Middle and Latter part strong winds at N.E. accompanied with snow and thick weather saw Nothing but Ships and a plenty of ice, Ship on Opposit tacks. No Obs.

Lat by account 61.52. N. Long 181.34. W

Monday May 30th
Commences with strong winds at N.E. Ship in the ice saw one Whale down to no purpose, Middle and Latter part fresh gales at N.E. with thick fog and rain Ship under short sail on Opposit tacks among the ice. several Ships in sight.
