

Tuesday June 22nd
Commences with light winds at 8th Ship leaving
W. Nothing in sight but ice middle and latter part
strong winds at 8 with thick fog squalls Ship leaving
W by 8 all sail set saw one Ship

Lat by obs 62, 26. N. Long by obs 176, 10. W

Wednesday June 23rd
All the 24 hours strong winds at 8 accompanied
with thick fog most of the time, 10 Ships in sight
and plenty of ice, no Whales.

Lat by obs 63, 17. N. Long by obs 175, 37.

Thursday June 24th
Commences with strong winds at 8 with thick fog
squalls Ship under short sail, several Ships in
sight, middle part thick fog. Latter part strong
winds at 8 Ship close to the Land 14 Ships in sight
no Whales. Lat by obs 63, 20. N. Long 175, 00.

Friday June 25th
Commences with strong winds at 8 with
thick weather Ship close to the Land middle
part much the same Latter part strong winds at
8 with thick fog and rain, saw one Ship,
Lat by obs 64, 58. N. Long 174, 50. W

Saturday June 25th
Commences with strong winds at 8 with
thick fog Ship leaving 8 by 8 Nothing in sight
Middle and latter part strong winds at 8
with rain and fog. Ship standing on opposite
tacks, saw one sail. No obs

Lat by account 62, 50. N. Long 175, 40. W

Sunday June 26th
Commences with light winds at 8 with thick
fog middle part light winds at 8 and clear at 6 O'clock
Ship Mary Ann Dolman, and Mary Nothing Latter part
light winds at 8. Steered N. W. saw several Whales
giving quick turned to no purpose. No obs
Lat by obs 63, 08. N. Long 174, 50. W

Monday June 27th
Commences with light winds at 8. 31 Ships in
sight saw several Whales giving quick
turned to no purpose middle part calm, Latter part
light winds at W Ship close to the ice, saw several
Whales. Turned to no purpose

Lat by obs 63, 36. N. Long 174, 05

Tuesday June 28th
Commences with light winds at W Ship close
to the Land and ice saw one Whale turned
to no purpose, 20 Ships in sight, Middle and latter
part light winds at N Ship on opposite tacks
close to the ice saw 2 Whales. Turned to no purpose
Lat by obs 63, 17. N. Long 174, 00. W

Wednesday June 29th
Commences with light winds at N Ship found
and ice in sight, Middle and latter part light
winds and calm, saw Whales giving quick to
the Southward. Turned to no purpose. No obs

Lat by account 63, 10. N. Long 174, 10

Thursday June 30th
Commences with light winds at N Whales in
sight close to the ice turned and chased different
Whales to no purpose middle part calm, Latter
part strong winds at 8 with thick fog squalls
15 Ships in sight plenty of ice and Land no Whales
Lat by obs 63, 17. N. Long 174, 05. W
