

Saturday July 9th.
Commences with light winds at 8 with thick fog. Ship under short sail leaving by finished Boiling. Middle and Latter part Calms with light air at 11 with thick fog saw nothing. Employed stowing down Oil. No Ob. Lat by account 63.15. N Long 179.10. W

Sunday July 10th.
Commences with light winds at 11 and thick fog. Ship heading W. N. W. at 2 P.M. the fog lifted & Ships in sight and the ice. Middle and Latter part light baffling winds saw a number of Whales. Landed and chased to no purpose, 6 Ships in sight. No Ob. Lat by account 63.12. N Long 179.04. W

Monday July 11th.
Commences with light air at 11. Nothing in sight but Ships and ice. Middle and Latter part Calms with baffling air, saw a number of Whales, at 4 A.M. fastened and hild at 9 took to the Ship got redly and commenced cutting, 14 Ships in sight and plenty of ice and fog. No Ob. Lat by account 63.10. N Long 179.08. W

Tuesday July 12th.
Commences with light winds at 8 with thick fog at 2 P.M. finished cutting; Middle part light winds at 11. Employed Boiling. Latter part Calms with baffling air saw several Whales. Boats off Chasing to no purpose. 20 Ships in sight the Land and plenty of ice. No Ob. Lat 63.14. N Long 179.00.

Wednesday July 13th.
Commences with a calm. Boats off in the ice saw several Whales to no purpose; middle part Calms. Latter part fresh breezes at 8. Ship close to the ice saw 3 Whales. Boats off all day in the ice to no purpose. 29 Ships in sight. Employed Boiling. No Ob. Lat by account 63.10. N Long 178.40.

Thursday July 14th.
Commences with strong winds at 8. with fresh squalls. saw nothing but Ships and ice. Employed Boiling. Middle part baffling winds finished Boiling. Latter part strong winds at 8. with rain. Ship under short sail saw 2 Whales 15 Ships and plenty of ice. Employed stowing down Oil. No Ob. Lat by account 63.05. N Long 178.35.

Friday July 15th.
Commences with strong winds at 8. with a thick rain storm. Ship under short sail finished stowing Oil. Middle part strong gales at 11. Latter part light baffling winds saw one Whale Landed to no purpose, several Ships in sight and plenty of ice. Lat by Obs 64.01. N Long 178.50. W

Saturday July 16th.
Commences with fresh breezes at 8. Ship in the ice saw one Whale Landed to no purpose. Middle part working W. N. W. through ice. Latter part Calms with baffling air, saw several Whales Landed and fastened to 2 Whales parted from one and got one. at Noon took the Whale a long side of 14 Ships in sight the Land and plenty of ice. No Ob. Lat by account 64.10. N Long 179.00. W

Sunday July 17th.
Commences with light winds. Employed cutting at 8 A.M. finished at Midnight saw one Whale Landed fastened and hild at 3 A.M. took a long side in the ice and commenced cutting, at Noon finished cutting 16 Ships in sight. No Ob. Lat by account 64.08. N Long 179.04.
