

Thursday July 26th.
Commenced with light winds at 8 am several Whales
going quick toward to our purpose, 24 Ships in
sight and the Land Middle and Light part showing
winds at 8.8. Ship heading S.W. saw nothing
but Ship and the Land at 9.10. A. B. sounded
got bottom at 12 fathoms, saw Ship to the S.E.
Lat. 46.54.41. Long. 150.40.00

Wednesday July 29th.
Came on as with strong wind at 8 P. steering
N. 2 Ship in sight, middle and Batter parts fresh
breezes at 8 P. with thick fog and rain Ship leaving
N.E. saw nothing. No 25
Sally account 64.10. 1st Dec 1796, W

Thursday July 28th.
Commenced with light winds at 8 & 8. Ship
sailing N & by E. one Ship in sight, Middle and
better part fresh gale at 8 & 8 with fog and rain
Ship standing on starboard tack, saw the Land off
Cape Chaplin. 6 Ships in sight, N & by E
But by account 64, 12. N. Long 178, 04. W

Friday July 24th.
Commenced with fresh gales at 8 P.M. with a
thick rain storm, middle part the same same
one Whale. Latter part light winds at 8 P.M. with
thick fog. Ship standing on off her it tooks, Nothing
in sight. At 11 P.M. but by the account 64220. N. Long 179° 20.

Saturday April 30th.
Commenced with light winds at 8. with thick
fog. Middle part the same. Better part fresh winds
at 8. Steered N by N. the Land in sight off Cape
Columbia, on Wales.
Sat 4th 63.54. Steered N by E 17 2.30. W

Sunday July 31st
Commences with light wind at S. steering N E by N
speak Ship Lucia also Redford & Whaler also Ship
Hunts of Harwood & Whaler, middle and latter part
fresh winds at S. with thick fog. Ship standing
on opposite tacks, saw 2 Hb's.
Took a glimpse of the Sun bet. 2.25 & 2.45 P.M. 17, 18, W.

Monday August 1st.
Commences with light winds at 8 A.M. with thick
fog most of the time, saw 2 Ships and the
Land at 5 P.M. later up saw plenty of small Whales
Some fastened the fog shut in thick but the fine lost
one hour middle part thick fog further part strong
winds at 1 P.M. Ship standing on opposite tacks
saw the Prince's Island in sight and 6 Ships
Sailed at 6 1/2 P.M. S. by 1/2 E. thro 16 & 34 W

Tuesday August 2nd
Commences with light winds at 11th Ship
heading N.W. King's Island in sight and 6th Ship
Middle's light airs at 11th Latter part light winds
at 11th Ship heading N.W. towards the Land
at 11th Ship Anchored under Cape pr. of Wales to
get Wood and Water.

Thursday August 3^d
Commenced with strong winds at N.W.
sent 2 Boats after Wood at 11 got wind loaded,
reported unphuberable for Wood at 6 P.M. took
the anchor and steered to the Eastward along
the Coast, at 1/2 past 7 P.M. saw plenty of Wood
on the Beach, dropped anchor in 8 fathoms
Middle past 8 o'clk. Latter part strong winds at
N.W. employed getting Wood and Water
