

Thursday August 4th

Commenced with light winds at 11 AM. hands
emplaced getting Wave and Water. at 6 PM
finished got 9 Boats loads of Wood and 130 bbls Water.
at 8 PM took the Anchor with light winds at
11 PM Ship heading W & W to W. Latter stormy
winds at 11 with thick fog most of the time
Nothing in sight but the Land.

Friday August 5th

All this 24 hours light falling winds with
thick fog most of the time 19 Ships in sight and
the Land. At 8 PM saw several Whales. Landed
to no purpose. spoke Rbs General Scott
3 Whales. At 8 AM calm dropped anchor, at 11 PM
the fog lifted, East Cape of Asia bearing N & W
Dist 7 Mils, plenty of Ships in sight and no Whales

Saturday August 6th

Commenced with light winds at 11 took
the Anchor and soon saw Whales in shore
Landed and Chased till 8 PM to no purpose
at 9 Calm dropped Anchor in 20 fathoms, Latter
part calm with thick fog and rain at 8 sent
the Boats in shore to look for Whales, ends with
thick fog. Ship at Anchor East Cape bearing
N Dist 10 Mils.

Sunday August 7th

Commenced with thick fog and rain. Nothing
in sight. at 5 PM Boats returned saw Nothing
Middle and Latter part fresh gales at 8 with
thick fog and rain saw Nothing. Ship at
Anchor East Cape bearing N Dist 10 Mils

Monday August 8th

Commenced with fresh gales at 8 & 8 with thick fog
and rain, middle part the same. Latter part calm
with the fog most of the time. Ship at Anchor sent
the Boats in shore to look for Whales saw Nothing
spoke Ship

Tuesday August 9th

Commenced with light winds at 8 with rain
Middle and Latter part fresh gales from
N & E to E & S with thick fog and rain Ship
at Anchor East Dist 10, sun & Ship.

Wednesday August 10th

Commenced with fresh gales at 8 & 8 with thick
fog and rain, middle part the same. Latter part
light winds at from N & E to E & S. at 8 AM fog lifted
took the Anchor, the fog soon shut in thick
Ship standing on Opposite tacks to keep clear
of the Land, sun & Ship no Whales.

Thursday August 11th

Commenced with light winds at 8 & 8 with
thick fog at 3 PM dropped Anchor. Nothing in
sight, middle and Latter part light winds and calm
with thick fog. Ship at Anchor. Flew Whales spouting



Friday August 12th

Commenced with calm and thick fog at 3 PM
saw several Whales in the fog close to the Ship
and heard plenty. Landed put in and killed at 8
PM the fog lifted saw the Boats towing the
Whale, at Midnight took the Whale a long ride
at 1 AM commenced cutting, Latter part fresh
gales with a rain storm from N & W at 11
AM finished cutting, 5 Ships in sight. Ship at
Anchor East Cape bearing for Campbell N & E Dist
6 Mils,
