

Saturday August 13th.
Commences with light winds & with fog squalls
and rain. Employed rarely saw Whales lowered
to no purpose. Middle part thick fog and rain. Latter
part light winds at S. with fog most of the time
spoke Bark Alice Kraxier Taker 1 Whale & 5 Hps in
sight. Employed Boiling.

Sunday August 14th.
Commences with light winds at S. with thick
fog. Middle part the same. Latter part light winds
at N. with fog and rain. saw Nothing Ship
at Anchor. Employed Boiling.

Monday August 15th.
Commences with light winds at N. with
thick fog at 1 P.M. the fog lifted for 15 Minutes
saw 7 Ships and the Land. Middle and Latter parts
strong gales at N.W. with fog squalls. Ship
at Anchor 6 Miles S.W. from East Cape. Employed
Boiling and stowing down Oil.

Tuesday August 16th.
Commences with strong gales at N.W.
with fog squalls at 2 P.M. finished Boiling. Middle
and Latter part the same. finished stowing down
Oil. Ship at Anchor 8 Miles from East Cape
saw several Ship in sight.

Wednesday August 17th.
Commences with strong gales at N.W.
with fog and rain squalls. Middle and Latter
part heavy gales with a rain storm. Ship at
Anchor East Cape Dist 6 Miles.

Thursday August 18th.
Commences with strong gales at N. with thick
fog squalls and rain saw several Whales lowered
but found it to engage to Whale and the fog shut in
to thick. Middle part strong gales at N. with
a rain storm. Latter part more moderate
saw Whales lowered and chased to no purpose
Ship at Anchor, 4 Ships in sight.

Friday August 19th.
Commences with light winds at N. Boats
off after Whales to no purpose. At 2 P.M. took
the Anchor. At 6 P.M. sent the Boats in shore
saw no Whales. Middle part light winds at N.W.
with thick fog. Ship heading N.W. Latter part
strong winds at N.W. with fog squalls. saw
2 Whales giving quick lower to no purpose
Ship in close to East Cape, 5 Ships in sight.

Saturday August 20th.
Commences with strong gales at N.W.
with fog squalls. Ship standing on Opposite
tacks close to East Cape. Middle and Latter parts
strong winds at N.W. with thick fog most of
the time. Ship standing on Opposite tacks
saw Nothing but Ships and Land.
But by account 66.30. N. Long 169.10. W.

Sunday August 21st.
Commences with light winds at N.W.
with thick weather. Middle part calm. Latter
part light winds at S. steered N.W. saw 5 Ships
and the Land spoke Bark North American
& Whales. But by obs 67.04. Long by account 171.00. W.
