in sight. Employed Bailing.

Sunday August 28th
Commences with strong winds at 8. saw
Nothing but Ship, middle and Latter part light

Commences with strong winds at 8 with
fog squalls saw 2 Whales Landed to no purpose

Bailing and commenced starting.
