Commences with light airs at N. turning S.W.
70 Ships in sight at 6 P.M. saw 2 Whales forced to no
purpose. finished stowing down Oil, middle
part Calm latter part strong gales at E.S.E.
with thick fog. saw nothing but Ship.
Lat by account 68.00. N Long 170.30 W

Wednesday August 31st
Commences with strong gales at S.E. with
fog squalls. Ship heading S.W. several Ships
in sight, middle and latter part light winds
at S. with thick fog and rain most of the time
Ship standing on opposite tacks saw nothing but
Ship. Lat by a glimpse of the Sun 68.09. N Long by account 170.25 W

Thursday September 1st
Commences with light winds at S. with thick
fog, middle part strong winds at S.W. with fog
and rain. latter part light winds at S.W. with
fog. Ship standing on opposite tacks saw nothing
but Ship. Lat by account 68.05. N Long 170.14 W

Friday Sept 2nd
Commences with light winds at S. with fog
and rain steering S. middle part and latter
part light winds and huffing with fog and
rain. Ship standing on opposite tacks
saw nothing but Ship. No Ob.
Lat by account 68.00. N Long 169.50 W

Saturday Sept 3rd
Commences with light winds at S. Ship heading
E.S.E. saw one Whale in the fog yawing quick
didn't lower middle and latter part light
airs and Calm with fog and rain saw 3 Whales
forced to no purpose. spoke Ship Niagara
full. got a Boat from her. No Ob.
Lat by account 68.10. N Long 169.48 W

Sunday Sept 4th
Commences with strong winds at East
with thick rain. weather sun. Nothing
but 1 Ship. middle part strong gales with
thick fog. latter part Calm saw one Whale
forced but saw nothing more of the Whale. 22 Ships
in sight. Lat by a glimpse of the Sun 68.51. N
Long & Elev 170.10.

Monday Sept 5th
Commences with strong winds at S. saw one
Whale forced and fasten the first long drawn
its recent iron spoke lost the Whale. at 11
P.M. saw one Whale lower fastened it at 12
line and Boat stove bad. and fire parted
lost the Whale 3 Boats spoke and run line.
middle and latter part strong gales
at S. Ship under short sail on opposite
tacks nothing in sight but Ship.
Lat by Ob 68.07. N Long & Elev 171.03 W

Tuesday Sept 6th
Commences with fresh gales at S. Nothing
in sight but Ship on beat the fore sail
and repaired it. middle and latter part light
winds with thick fog most of the time.
spoke Ship Braganza small 2 Whales.
Lat by Ob 68.07. N Long & Elev 169.07 W

Wednesday Sept 7th
Commences with a Calm 15 Ships in sight
spoke Ship Stephania Long 2 Whales. middle
and latter part light winds at S. with
thick fog spoke Ship Alfred Gibbs James
5 Whales. No Ob.
Lat by account 68.00. N Long 170.00 W
