

Thursday Sept 8th

Commences with light winds at N. with thick fog. Middle and latter part thick fog as usual. At N. saw several ships. One ship. Inayon Barber Bond out. Ship standing on opposite tack under short sail.

Friday Sept 9th

Commences with light winds at N. with thick fog. Ship heading N. W. Middle and latter part strong winds at N. with thick fog and rain spoke ship track. Hocks & Whales.

No Ob. Lat by account 67.48. N. Long 170.00.

Saturday Sept 10th

Commences with strong winds at N. with thick weather. Middle and latter part strong gales at N. with thick overcast weather. Ship standing on opposite tack saw nothing but ships.

No Ob. Lat by account 67.40. Long 172.00. W.

Sunday Sept 11th

Commences with ~~light~~ strong gales at N. Ship heading S. N. E. Middle and latter part the same with thick fog and rain saw several ships. No Ob.

Lat by account 67.25. N. Long 170.15. W.

Monday Sept 12th

Commences with fresh gales at N. with thick overcast weather. Ship heading S. N. E. 11 ships in sight. Middle part much the same. Latter part calm saw nothing but ships.

Lat by Ob 67.32. N. Long by Chron 168.57. W.

Tuesday Sept 13th

Commences with light winds at N. Nothing in sight but ship. Middle and latter part light winds at N. steered S. E. sent up the Fore Top Gallant yard and sail. Lat by Ob 66.51. Long by Chron 164.31. W.

Wednesday Sept 14th

Commences with light winds at N. steering S. E. & 7 ships in sight saw several Humphreys lower to no purpose sent the Mispense Top Gallant yard, cleaft. and sail. Middle part light winds at N. steered S. E. & 8, at 2 N. M. have to till day light. Latter part strong winds at N. with fog squalls and rain. Steered N. at 7 A. M. past East Cape Dist 2 Miles, 11 ships in sight. No Ob. Lat by account 65.25. N. Long 170.25.

Thursday Sept 15th

Commences with light winds at N. with thick rainey weather steering S. W. all sail. At the Land in sight, and 2 ships. Middle and latter part light winds in Calm with thick weather most of the time. The Land in sight Dist 10 Miles, 9 ships in sight.

No Ob. Lat by account 64.48. N. Long 170.56.

Friday Sept 16th

Commences with a Calm and thick overcast weather the Land in sight and several ships. Middle part the same. Latter part a fine breeze at N. steering S. E. all drawing sail. At 11 ships in sight at 11 A. M. past Cape Chapman Dist 10 Miles. Employed taking the anchor on the Bore on board the Chain and stowed it below.
