

Saturday Sept 17th.
Commences with a fine breeze at N steering S by E
all sail set 11 Ships in sight, Middle and latter
part light winds and hupling from N to S by E
steered S by E. saw Nothing but Ships.

Lat by obs 62, 34. N. Long & thro 179, 13. W

Sunday Sept 18th.
Commences with light winds at N steering
S by E. 5 Ships in sight, Middle and latter part
light airs and calms. Nothing in sight but Ships
spoke Ship Heroine's Whaler. No obs

Lat by account 61, 54. N. Long 179, 25. W

Monday Sept 19th.
All the 24 hours hupling airs and calms with
few squalls. saw 5 Ships, 10th employed in
Ships duty. Lat by obs 61, 19. N. Long & thro 179, 27. W

Tuesday Sept 20th.
All the 24 hours hupling winds and calms
Ships working to the S. saw Nothing but
Ships and St. Matthews Island. repaired the
Main top Gallant Sail.

Lat by obs 60, 44. N. Long & thro 179, 25. W

Wednesday Sept 21st
Commences with light winds at S (Ship)
steering S by E, St. Matthews Island dist
8 Miles, 7 Ships in sight, at 6 P.M. saw several
in Whale Lanes to no purpose, caught 16 Cod
fish, at daylight saw Whales 2 or 3 fastened
and killed at 4 P.M. took the Whale a long ride
saw more Whales put off to no purpose at
11 A.M. commenced cutting, Lulls with light
winds at N.E. and fine weather Ship close
to the Island 13 Ships in sight

Lat by account 60, 30. N. Long 179, 00. W

Thursday Sept 22nd
Commences with light winds at S by E. at 1 P.M.
finished cutting, made sail saw Whales lowered
fastened and killed the Whale sunk lost 14 Trons &
Trons and 60 fathoms line, 16 Ships in sight, middle
part strong winds at N.E. steered S by E. latter
part strong gales at N.E. steered S by E. all pendant
sail saw Nothing.

Lat by obs 58, 31. N. Long & account 179, 05

Friday Sept 23rd
Commences with strong gales at N.E. with
thick fog, steering S by E. all pendant sail at
middle and latter part the same. saw 2 Ships.
Lat by a glimpse of the Sun 55, 07. N. Long 179, 08

Saturday Sept 24th.
Commences with fresh gales at N. steering
S by E. all drawing sail set over Ships in sight
middle part strong gales at N steering S by E at 1 P.M.
shortened sail and have two till daylight, latter
part strong winds at N.W. steered S by E. all
drawing sail, at 4 P.M. saw the Fox
Islands, at 11 P.M. between them 1 Ship
in sight. Lat by obs 54, 38. N. Long & thro 179, 28. W

Sunday Sept 25th.
Commences with strong winds at N.W.
and squally steering S by E. all drawing sail set
middle part the same, latter part light winds
at N. steering S by E. and sail in sight. Employed
Boiling. Lat by obs 49, 40. N. Long & thro 179, 05. W
