Commenced with fresh winds at 8th Ship
heading N N E. middle and latter part light
winds accompanied with thick fog. Ship under
short sail saw nothing. Employed in sailing.

Friday Dec 16th
Commenced with light winds at 8th Ship
heading N N E under short sail thick fog. at 4 P.M.
the fog lifted saw one Whale close to the Ship pursued
to no purpose, soon sunset saw 2 Whales didn't
pursue. Middle and latter part visible with
fog and rain squalls. Ship standing on
opposite tacks. Employed in sailing at 11 P.M.
finished sailing.
