

Friday January 6th
Commences with strong gales at 8th ship heading
N.W. Middle part strong gales from
N.W. to N.E. Ship on opposite tacks saw nothing
No obs. Lat & account 45.48. S. Long 175.30. W

Saturday January 7th
Commences with strong winds at 7th ship heading
S.W. Middle strong winds at 8th ship heading N. under
short sail. Latter steered N.W. saw nothing
Lat & obs 45.37. S. Long 176.49. W

Sunday January 8th
Commences with strong winds at 8th steering
N.W. all four sails set, middle part light and
battering. Latter part strong winds at 8th ship heading
S.W. to N.E. at 5 A.M. saw the
South end of Chatham Island bearing for compass
N by E. Dist 30. Miles.
Lat & obs 44.36. S. Long 176.52. W

Monday January 9th
Commences with strong gales at 8th and nearest
ship close to the Pyramid, middle and latter
part strong gales at 8th with thick weather
most of the time ship on opposite tacks
saw nothing but the land. No obs
Lat & account 44.12. S. Long 176.57. W

Tuesday January 10th
Commences with light winds at 8th with
thick rainy weather the Pyramid dist 8. Miles
Middle part light with rain. Latter part strong
winds at 8th and squally. Ship close to Pitt Island
saw nothing but the land.
Lat & obs 44.12. S. Long 177.00. W

Wednesday January 11th
Commences with strong winds at 8th ship
opposite tacks close to the land, middle part light
latter part strong gales at 8th with thick weather
saw nothing but the land. No obs
Lat & account 44.30. S. Long 177.04. W

Thursday January 12th
Commences with strong gales at 7th ship off
the Pyramid, middle part the same. Latter part
strong winds at 8th ship standing on opposite
tacks. saw nothing but the land. Lamprey repairing
the fore top guttunt sail.
Lat & obs 45.00. S. Long 177.05. W

Friday January 13th
Commences with strong winds at 7th ship
heading N.W. Nothing in sight but Pinbacks
middle part strong day by under short sail
latter part light ones at 8th steered N.E. to N.W.
saw nothing but the land. No obs
Lat & account 44.05. S. Long 177.30. W

Saturday January 14th
Commences with a calm the Sisters and West
reef in sight dist 10 Miles bearing from S to
N.W. at 6 o'clock got up the foreward chain and
bent it. at 7 light winds at 8th ship headed N.W.
middle part the same. at daylight were
ship headed S.W. to N.E. all sail set at 7 A.M.
saw the land on West reef bearing S. dist 10 Miles
at 12 part of saw Bonkers ahead. Dist 3 Miles tacked
to the Westward. wind N.W. saw nothing more
Lat & obs 43.33. S. Long 178.00. W
