the Sisters. Dist 10 Mils.

Monday January 16th
Commenced with light winds at S.W. Steering for
Chatham Island at 3 P.M. Boat came along side at 11.
went on shore to trade. at sunset returned with one
Boat load of Potatoes, Middle and better parts
light winds at S.W. with fine weather Ship off
and on trading on the South side of Chatham
Island.

Tuesday January 17th
Commenced with light winds at S.W. Ship off and
on trading, middle part the same. better part calm
Ship at anchor 3 Mils from the Land in full moon.
Employed getting recruits on Board.

Wednesday January 18th
Commenced with a calm. Ship at anchor
recruiting. at sundown finished got all that we
had got Potatoes no ripe yet 4 Tuns, and 14 Pigs
large and small, middle part calm. better part
light winds at N.W. at daylight took the anchor
steered West. Lat & Lon 41.38. S. Decr 179. 26.

Thursday January 19th
Commenced with light winds at N.W. Ship
heading West. At 6 P.M. spoke the Robt. Morrison
Boston 1000 bbls. middle part light winds. better
part light winds at N.W. with fog squalls. Ship on
Opposit track, employed exchanging Articles
got 2 Casks of Bread & 1 Bar of Tobacco

Friday January 20th
Commenced with light winds at N.W. Ship on
Opposit track in company with Robt. Morrison, middle
and better part light winds at N.W. Steered S.E. to S.W.
middle part light winds at N.W. Ship on
Lat & Lon 44.30. S. Decr 179. 10. W.

Saturday January 21st
Commenced with light winds at N.W. Ship
heading S. Middle part thick fog lay by under
short heading S.W. better part strong winds
at N.W. cut Ship heading S.E. saw 1 sail
Lat & Lon 45.15. S. Decr 179. 44. W.

Sunday January 22nd
Commenced with strong winds at N. Ship
heading S.E. one Ship in sight, middle
part lay by. better part light winds at N.W.
heading W. Nothing in sight.
Lat & Lon 45.00. Decr 179. 14. W.

Monday January 23rd
Commenced with light winds at N.W. heading
W. saw one sail, at 6 P.M. spoke the Roman Triff
Round Lane. at daylight exchanged new Articles
middle and better part light winds at N.W.
with fog squalls heading S.E. saw 1 Ship, and
Lat & Lon 44.56. S. Decr 179. 03. W.

Tuesday January 24th
Commenced with light winds at N.W. heading S.E.
Nothing in sight, middle part light fog lay by. better
part light winds at N. heading W. N.W. saw one
sail. employed in Ship's duty.
