

Sunday February 5th
Commences with light winds at N. Ship on
Opposite tack, making up to the Potato hole
middle and latter part light winds at N. Ship off
and on at Chatham Island.

Monday February 6th
Commences with light winds at N. middle the
same, latter part light winds at N.W. with thick
fog and rain. at 1/2 past 11. A. M. rounded up
Bottom at 18 fathoms Dredged Anchor

Tuesday February 7th
Commences with light winds at N.W. with thick
fog. Ship at anchor. All hands employed
fishing. Caught quite a lot. middle part calm
with thick fog. latter calm and clear. Ship at
anchor 6 miles from Cape Jones. Employed
getting Potatoes on Board.

Wednesday February 8th
Commences with light winds at N.W. at
3 P.M. took the anchor and dropped down
the coast 6 miles to the Eastward at a village
middle part light winds at N.W. with thick
rainy weather. latter part light with thick
fog. got all the Potatoes on Board. say about
16 Bums. and 14 Hugs.

Thursday February 9th
Commences with light winds at N.W. with
thick fog. at 2 P.M. took the anchor
headed N.W. all sail set, middle and latter
part light winds at N.W. with fog and rain. saw
Nothing Employed in this duty.

Friday Feb 10th
Commences with light winds at N.W. heading N.W. S.
middle part huffing with many. latter part brisk
breezes at S.W. steering N.W. all Draining sail
set saw Nothing. Employed mainly.

Saturday February 11th
Commences with light winds at S. steering
N.W. middle part light winds at Eastward
latter part light winds from S. to N.W. Ship
from N.W. to W. S. W. saw Nothing. Employed
sawing Potatoes.

Lat & Long 39.54. S. Long & Chas 177.57. W.

Sunday February 12th
Commences with light winds at N.W. heading
N.W. middle and latter part light winds at N.W. heading
N.W. saw Nothing.

Lat & Long 39.21. S. Long & Chas 176.55. W.

Monday February 13th
Commences with light winds at N.W.
heading N.W. middle part huffing with rain squalls
latter part calm with light winds saw Nothing.
Employed sawing Potatoes.

Lat & Long 38.35. S. Long & Chas 176.11. W.

Tuesday Feb 14th
Commences with light winds at N.W. heading
N.W. middle part stormy winds at N.W. heading
N.W. latter part light winds at N.W. with rain squalls
saw Black Bird larvae and got 2 fish. No other
