

Saturday February 25th

Commenced with fresh winds at E steering NW
Middle and Latter part the same saw nothing
Employed variously

Lat by Obs 14.33. S Long by Chron 177.31 W

Sunday Feb 26th

Commenced with light winds at E. S. steering
W by N. At 6 P.M. made Horn Island bearing E 68°
Dist 25 Miles. Middle part lay by under short
sail. Latter part fresh breeze at E at daylight
steamed for the Landing place, at 11 several
cannoes came a long side, the bed plenty on
shore it being Sunday could not trail. at 10
A.M. our Boat went on shore

Monday Feb 27th

Commenced with light winds at E Ship
off and on at Horn Island, middle and latter
part baffling winds and calms with rain
squalls. Ship 10 Miles from the Land

Tuesday Feb 28th

Commenced with a Calm accompanied with
rain squalls. Middle and latter parts light
winds at E. At 8 A.M. anchored at Horn Island
in 14 fathoms 2 cables lengths from the reef. Employed
Weathering.

Wednesday March 1st

All the 24 hours light winds at Easter and
accompanied with showers of rain Employed
Weathering and getting recruits, one Watch on
a shore on Liberty.

Thursday March 2nd

All the 24 hours light winds at E with heavy
rain showers Employed variously, one Watch on
shore

Friday March 3rd

All the 24 hours strong winds at N accompanied
with heavy showers of rain, Employed getting what
and recruits on Board one Watch on Liberty

Saturday March 4th

All the 24 hours strong winds at N with
showers of rain Employed Weathering and recruiting
one Watch on Liberty, Almon's Vickers Decoded

Sunday March 5th

All the 24 hours strong winds at N with
heavy squalls and heavy showers of rain
Ship at anchor

Monday March 6th

All the 24 hours fresh breeze at E with
showers of rain, Employed getting recruits
on Board, one Watch on Liberty

Tuesday March 7th

All the 24 hours light winds at E accompanied
with showers of rain, finished recruiting, Argyle
took the anchor and proceeded to sea, All hands
Employed, various logs Lat 14.10. S Long 178.13. W

Wednesday March 8th

Commenced with light winds at E steering NW
Horn Island Dist 5 Miles, Employed stowing lumber
and chains Middle and latter parts light winds
at E steering NW saw nothing Employed
variously, fitting and painting Boats mending
cannon &c &c.
