Commences with a hard squall of wind and rain at N.W. Ship heading N. middle part strong winds at N.W. and squally with rain. Latter part light winds at N.W. with hard squalls and heavy showers of rain. Ship under short sail. saw Nothing. No Obs

Thursday March 23rd

Commences with light winds at N.W. accompanied with a rain storm. Ship heading West. Middle part light winds at N. with squalls and rain. Lightning and thunder all sorts of weather and it seems so that it never was gentler weather since. Latter light winds at N. with hard squalls from W. and heavy showers of rain.
