Commences with fresh breezes at W steering
N by W, middle and latter part strong gales
at N heading W by W under storm sails ran
Nothing. Lat by account 35.00. N. Long 149.40. E

Thursday April 27th

Commences with strong gales at N heading
W by W, middle part calm, latter part light airs
at N steering N. saw Nothing employed variously
Lat by Obs 35.23. N. Long 149.15. E

Friday April 28th

Commences with light winds at N steering N
all drawing sail. Middle part much the
same. Latter part light winds at N with
thick fog, steer N. saw Nothing
No Obs. Lat by account 40.20. N. Long 149.20

Saturday April 29th

Commences with light winds at W by W with
fog steering N. middle and latter light winds
at N by N steer N by E. saw Nothing employed
variously. Lat by Obs 42.31. N. Long 148.36. E

Sunday April 30th

Commences with light winds at N steering
N by E. at 6 P.M. spoke Ship Pacific Men.
Middle and latter part light baffling winds
from N to N by E. with thick fog, saw Nothing
No Obs. Lat by account 43.00. N. Long 148.40. E

Monday May 1st

Commences with a calm and thick fog
middle light winds at W. latter part strong
winds at N W with snow squalls steer
N by E all product sail. No Obs. saw Nothing
Lat by Obs 44.14. N. Long by account 150.01

Tuesday May 2nd

Commences with strong winds at N by N
steering N by E. middle and latter part strong
gales at N by N steer N by E. all product sail. No
saw one Ship

Lat by Obs 46.13. N. Long 150.24. E

Wednesday May 3rd

Commences with strong gales at N by N steering
N by E. middle part lay by under short sail. heading
N by W. latter part light winds at N by N steer
N by W. saw Nothing No Obs

Lat by account 46.50. N. Long 155.14. E

Thursday May 4th

Commences with a calm middle part the same
latter part light winds at W by W heading N
saw one Ship, employed in Ship's duty
Lat by Obs 47.44. N. Long 155.40. E

Friday May 5th

Commences with light winds at W by W heading
N. saw one or two Whales forced to no purpose
Middle and latter part light baffling winds
from N by N at 4 P.M. saw 2 or 3 Whales forced
to no purpose, one Ship in sight

Lat by Obs 47.43. N. Long 155.24. E.

by time 156.01.

Saturday May 6th

Commences with light winds at N by N. Boats
in chase of the 2 Whales to no purpose at 7 P.M.
latter for the same 2 Whales with out success. Middle
and latter part light winds at N heading
N by W. saw Nothing but the Humble by the
Lat by Obs 48.20. N.
