

Sunday May 7th

Commences with light winds at W steering
along the Islands Middle part calm. Latter
strong winds at N & accompanied with snow
squalls. Store them between the Islands in
to the Ochotsk Sea, saw nothing but Land.

Monday May 8th

Commences with strong winds at N & E
leading N & W. Middle part light and latter
part fresh breezes at N & W leading N & E. saw
8 ships at 4 P.M. spoke ship Deyon.

Tuesday May 9th

Commences with light winds at N & W
leading N & E. several ships in sight, at 3
P.M. spoke Rank Antelope. Latter Middle and
latter part light winds at N & W. Ship on
opposite tack 3 ships in sight, engaged
in ship, Lat by obs 50, 45. N. Long 154, 54. E

Wednesday May 10th

Commences with a calm and fine pleasant
weather, middle and latter part strong
winds at E. store N. 2 ships in sight.

Lat by obs 51, 11. N. Long 154, 54. E

Thursday May 11th

Commences with strong winds at N & E
leading N & W. Middle part strong winds
at N leading N & W. Latter part strong
winds at N & W leading N & E. 5 ships in sight
N & W. Lat 52, 47. Long 154, 50. E

Friday May 12th

Commences with light winds at N & W leading
N & E. at 4 P.M. spoke ship Flibertia. Latter
Middle and latter part light winds at N & W.
Leading N. saw nothing but one ship.

Saturday May 13th

Commences with light winds at N & W
leading N. Middle part light winds at W leading
N & W. at day light 23 ships in sight and a plenty
of ice one ship Boiling and one cutting, saw
no Whales. Latter part light winds at W steering
N & E along the ice. N & E

Lat by account 55, 40. N. Long 153, 30. E

Sunday May 14th

Commences with a calm nothing but ships
and ice in sight, spoke ship China. 1 Whale
Middle and latter part light winds from
N. Ships on opposite tack, 10 ships in sight
and a plenty of ice.

Lat by obs 56, 50. N. Long 154, 48. E

Monday May 15th

Commences with light winds at N the same
in sight as usual ice and ships, at 5 P.M. spoke
ship Cleone Sherman 1 Whale. 20 ships Count Cleane
Middle part calm, Lat by obs light winds
at N & W leading N & W. saw nothing
but ships and ice.

Lat by obs 57, 16. N. Long 150, 30. E
