Republic of Renoir 1 whale ends with
light airs and a thick snow storm

Commences with strong winds at 8 P.M. Ship

winds at N. with thick overcast weather 18 ships

Friday May 19th

Commences with light airs at W.N.W. with snow
squalls Ship leading 8 W threw the ice, middle
and latter part light winds at W. with thick fog
most of the time. Ship under short sail in the ice

Mundack Nothing No Obs

Saturday May 20th

Commences with light winds at W with thick
fog. Ship under short sail. finished Reeling
Employed Scraping Boats, middle and latter
part light winds at W with fog squalls Ship
on opposite tacks close to the ice 17 ships in
sight no whales. Employed stowing down oil

Sunday May 21st

Commences with light winds at W with
fog squalls middle and latter part light
Ship marking a long the ice saw nothing but
Ship and ice Last 4 Obs 57, 14, N. Day 151, 05

Monday May 22nd

Commences with light winds at W. Ship
working along the ice Nothing in sight but
ships middle and latter part thick fog lay by
saw Nothing No Obs Last 4 account 57, 18, N. Day 151, 10,

Tuesday May 23rd

Commences with light winds at 8 P.M. Ship
leading 8. Nothing in sight but Ship and ice
middle and latter part light winds at W. Ship
in the ice under short sail, saw one whale &
boats in chase, lower to no purpose. 18 Ship in
sight. Employed setting up Hooks.

Wednesday May 24th

Commences with light airs at N with snow
Ship in the ice saw one whale lower to no
purpose middle and latter part light airs at W
with thick fog lay by saw Nothing but ice
