

Thursday May 25th
Commences with light winds at W. with thick fog
Ship in the ice laying by. Middle and latter part
the same several ships. No Ob.
Lat by Occurrent 57, 28. N Long 151, 35. E

Friday May 26th
Commences with light winds at W. with thick
fog. Ship in the ice under short sail. Middle
part thick fog. Latter part light winds at West. at
W. M. saw 11 Whales going quick in the ice
latter to no purpose. 18 ships in sight.
Lat by Obs 57, 36. N. Long by Chron 150, 57. E

Saturday May 27th
Commences with light winds at W. W. Ship
leading N. W. threw the ice under short sail
middle part the same. Latter part strong winds
at W. Ship on opposite tacks, saw the Land off
lope Bligh. Ship and a plenty of ice in sight
no Whales. Lat & Obs 57, 50. N. Long by Chron 150, 24.

Sunday May 28th
Commences with strong winds at W.
middle and latter part much the same. Ship
on opposite tacks. Nothing in sight but ships
and ice. Lat & Obs 58, 00. N. Long by Chron 150, 34. E.

Monday May 29th
Commences with light winds at W. Steering
Eastward along the ice. spoke ship Thomas
Dickerson. Taken 2 Whales. Middle and latter part
strong winds at W. Ship on opposite tacks the same
in sight as usual. Ship and ice.
Lat & Obs 57, 39. N. Long 150, 30. E

Tuesday May 30th
Commences with strong winds at W. heading N. W.
Middle part calm. Latter part strong winds at
S. E. with thick fog most of the time. Steered W. to
N. W. saw 1 ship.
Lat by Obs 58, 04. N. Long by Chron 149, 36

Wednesday May 31st
Commences with strong winds at S. E. steering
N. W. middle part lapping with calms. Latter
part light winds at S. E. steered S. W. by W. saw
the Land and 4 ships.
Lat by Obs 58, 10. N. Long by Chron 148, 25. E

Thursday June 1st
Commences with light winds at S. E. steering
S. W. W. Middle and latter part light winds
at W. N. W. Ship leading S. W. saw. Nothing but ships
Lat by Obs 56, 53. N. Long by Chron 146, 34. E

Friday June 2nd
Commences with light winds at W. S. W.
heading S. E. 12 ships in sight. middle part strong
winds at S. E. with thick rainy weather. Steered
W. by S. Latter strong winds with thick weather
at 4 A. M. saw Jones Island 5 Miles Dist
shortened sail and lapped by the winds. spoke
Ship Jefferson. Nothing and pinch swift clothing
No Ob. Lat by account 56, 50. N. Long 147, 30. W

Saturday June 3rd
Commences with strong winds at East with
thick fog. middle part much the same
at 6 A. M. saw one Whale lapped to no purpose
at W. lapped to no purpose. No Ob.
Lat by account 56, 45. N. Long 147, 10. E
