lowered after chasing 5 hours got off got one
Boat stove and lost 225 fathoms line.

 Monday June 5th
Commenced with strong winds at 1st 8. Boats
off part to the Whale at 3 P.M. took the Whale on
long side at 4 commenced cutting at 7 finished
middle and latter part light winds saw
Whales lowered and chased to no purpose. Plenty
of Hiss in night. No Ob

Tuesday June 6th
Commenced with light winds at 8 Boats off
Chase Whales to no purpose. at 3 lowered
at 5 got part the Whale took 225 fathoms line
lost the Whale and line, middle part light
winds. Latter part strong winds at 1st
with thick fog most of the time, employed
Boiling. No Ob

Wednesday June 7th
Commenced with strong winds at 1st 8. with
fog and rain. middle and latter part light winds
with thick fog most of the time saw several
ships, also Whales to much fog to Whales employed
Boiling.

Thursday June 8th
Commenced with light winds at Eastward with fog
squalls saw Whales lowered to no purpose
finished Boiling. middle and latter part calm
with thick fog most of the time saw Whales
to much fog to Whales employed stowing oil
Lat & Long 55.46. N Long account 148.05 E

Friday June 9th
Commenced with light winds at W with thick
fog, saw nothing. finished stowing oil,
middle Calm. Latter part light winds at 8.
saw Whales lowered part and killed.
Lat & Long account 55.50. N Long 148.04 E

 Saturday June 10th
Commenced with light winds at 8 Boats
off part to the Whale, at 2 P.M. took the Whale
on long side and commenced cutting at 7 finished
middle and latter part light winds
at 8. saw Whales lowered to no purpose
Lat & Long 55.48. N Long by Chron 148.06 E

Sunday June 11th
Commenced with light winds at 8. saw
one Whale lowered to no purpose spoke ship
Walter Scott's Whale, middle part light. Latter
strong winds at 8. Ship on opposite took
close to the ice, saw several Whales growing
quick in to the ice, didn't lower 20 fathoms in night
Employed Boiling
