

Monday June 12th.
Commences with fresh gales at 8. Ship under
short sail close to the ice Boiling, middle
and latter part light winds at 8. Ship on opposite
tacks in the ice plenty of ships in sight, saw
one Whale lumen to no purpose. Employed
Boiling. Lat by Obs 55.29. N Long 141.00. E.

Tuesday June 13th.
Commences with strong winds at 8. Ship
close to the ice Boiling, saw one Whale
lumen to no purpose, middle part finished
Boiling, latter part strong winds at 8.
Ship in the ice saw one Whale lumen to
no purpose. Employed storing oil.

Lat by account 55.34. N Long 140.30. E

 Wednesday June 14th.
Commences with a calm nothing in sight
but ship and ice finished storing oil
middle part calm, latter part light
winds at 8. Ship in the ice at 5 A.M. saw
Whales lumen part and killed one Whale at
7 took the Whale along side, 8 Boats left
chasing Whales to no purpose, found
a dead Whale, left one Boat by the Whale
Employed Cutting. No obs.

Lat by account 55.36. N Long 140.45. E

 Thursday June 15th.
Commences with light winds at 8 at 2 P.M.
finished Cutting made all sail to take
the dead Whale, at 4 took the Whale along
side at 5 commenced Cutting at 9 finished
all this day the ship a many heavy ice
and got some heavy thumps to heavy all
together if I get what oil I want and
don't sink the ship I shall think my self
lucky. Latter part strong winds, Employed Boiling

Friday June 16th.
Commences with strong winds at 8 Ship close to the
ice plenty of ships in sight Employed Boiling
middle part much the same. Latter part light
winds at 8 & W. saw nothing but ship and ice
No obs Lat by account 55.28. N Long 141.00. E.

Saturday June 17th.
Commences with light winds at 8 Ship
under short sail close to the ice no Whale
in sight, Employed Boiling, middle part
thick fog, latter part light winds at 8. Ship
close to the ice, no Whales, Employed Boiling
and storing oil. Lat by Obs 55.29. N Long 141.15. E.

Sunday June 18th.
Commences with light winds plenty of ships
and ice in sight, Employed Boiling and storing
oil, middle part thick fog, latter part strong
winds at 8. saw Whales in the ice lumen to no
purpose, finished Boiling.

Lat by Obs 55.31. N Long 140.19. E

 Monday June 19th.
Commences with light winds at 8 Ship close
to the ice no Whales in sight, Employed Coopering
oil and breaking out to stow between Decks
middle part thick fog latter light winds at 8.
saw nothing, Employed storing oil.
Lat by Obs 55.27. N Long 142.25. E

 Tuesday June 20th.
Commences with light winds at 8 Ship
close to the ice sent the Boats in the ice saw
several Whales among the heavy ice, found a dead
Whale hooked on and towed out of the ice at 9 P.M.
took the Whale along side, at 11 A.M. commenced
Cutting at 9 finished made sail to quit the ice
Lat by Obs 55.37. N Long 142.25. E
