Saturday June 24th
Commences with light winds at S. W. Ship
under short sail thick fog most of the
time. spoke Ship Speedwell & Whales. Middle
thick fog. Latter part strong winds at S. Ship
under short sail among the ice. Employed
storing oil. Lat by obs 55.22. N Long by obs 141.20

Sunday June 25th
Commences with strong winds at S. steering
N. W. along the ice saw Nothing but Ships
middle and latter part light winds at S with
thick fog most of the time saw Nothing but Ships
and ice. No obs
Lat by account 55.14. N Long 141.00

Monday June 26th
Commences with light winds at S. with thick fog
middle and latter part light winds and calms. saw one
Whale. Landed to no purpose. spoke Ship Adeline
Gills & Whales. No obs
Lat by account 55.10. N Long 142.24. E

Tuesday June 27th
Commences with a calm plenty of Ship and ice, no
Whales middle and latter part light winds at
S. Ship steering to the S. W. along the ice.
saw no Whales. Lat by obs 55.20. N Long by account 142.24

Wednesday June 28th
Commences with light winds at S heading
S. S. close to the ice. Middle and latter part strong
winds at S. N. E. with thick fog. saw Nothing
but Ships. Employed repairing Boats.
No obs Lat by account 55.22. N Long 142.15. E

Thursday June 29th
Commences with strong winds at S. with
fog squalls steering W. & W. middle and
latter part light winds at S with fog squalls.
steering and fighting, steamed W. & S. saw one
Whale Landed to no purpose. finished repairing
Boats. Lat by obs 54.55. N Long 140.15. E

Friday June 30th
Commences with light winds at W. with thick
fog. Employed raising up Hooks. Middle and
latter part calms with thick fog. saw several
Ships. No obs Lat by account 54.19. N Long 140.30
