

Saturday July 1st
Commences with a calm and thick fog. Nothing
in sight middle and latter part the same
No obs. Lat by account 54.45. N Long 140.32. E

Sunday July 2nd
Commences with a calm and thick fog squalls
middle and latter part light airs at E. S. E. strong
W. thick fog most of the time saw several ships
Lat by obs in the fog 54.31. N Long 140.20. E

Monday July 3rd
Commences with light airs at S. E. with
thick fog and strong tide rips, middle and latter
part light airs and calms. Ship in offshoot
tacks saw the land near the Shanties. 20 ships
in sight no Whales. Lat by obs 54.34. N Long 139.52. E

Tuesday July 4th
Commences with light baffling winds. Land
ice and ships in sight. Middle and latter part
baffling winds. Ship close to the ice. Boat in
shore. Lat by obs 54.19. N Long 139.10. E

Wednesday July 5th
Commences with light airs at S. Boat off in
shore at 7 P.M. returned. Land on a small
Island say 5 miles from the Main. saw from
20 to 30 Whales close to the shore. found the
current running from 4 to 6 miles per hour
with heavy cakes of ice at the same rate
did not trouble any of the Whales as there
was no chance to save one, as the ship
was from 10 to 12 miles off and heavy ice
between the ship and Land. Middle and latter
part light baffling winds and calms saw several
Whales moving ~~fast~~ quick in shore. There
the ice, found to no purpose. No obs.
Lat by account 54.20. N Long 139.20. E

Thursday July 6th
Commences with a calm and thick fog. Middle
and latter part light airs and calms with fog
most of the time. Ship ice and land in sight
Lat by obs 54.14. N Long 139.15. E

Friday July 7th
Commences with thick fog and calm. Middle
and latter part variable winds and weather
Ship close to the Land. sent the Boats in saw
several Whales. No obs. Lat by account 54.10. N
Long 139.12. E

Saturday July 8th
Commences with light baffling winds. Boat
in shore after Whales got fast and killed one
at 10 P.M. took the Whale a long side
at 3 P.M. Commences cutting at 6 finished
made all sail and stood in for the Land
at 8 sent the Boats in. Look with strong
winds at 8 P.M. Ship close to the Land. No obs.
Lat by account 54.05. N Long 139.15. E

Sunday July 9th
Commences with strong winds at S. E. at 4 P.M.
the Boat returned saw 14 Whales gaining quick
steamed W. N. W. middle and latter part strong
winds at S. E. with thick fog. Ship under short
sail have two. saw nothing but ice and Land.
No obs. Lat by account 54.25. N Long 139.00. E

Monday July 10th
Commences with a calm. Ship in the ice with
thick fog. Middle and latter part light airs and
baffling. with thick fog most of the time saw
2 ships and the Land. Employed Boiling. No obs.
Lat by account 54.22. N Long 139.04. E
