



Sunday August 13th
Commenced with light winds at 8. Boats off
Employed Bailing, saw 3 Whales to no purpose
middle and latter part bailing winds with
fog squalls and rain. Boats off found a Dead Whale
at 9 AM tripe anchor at 11 took the Whale a
long side, drape anchor, ends with thick
fog and the winds breaving on to a gale from
S.W.

Monday August 14th
Commenced with strong winds at N.E.
with fog employed cutting at 4 finished, it
blewing a strong gale at the time bent the
Starboard anchor and let go, middle part
bailing with squalls and calms, latter
part calm. Employed, neverly Bailing
took up the Starboard anchor cooping and
stowing oil, saw nothing but Ship and Land

Tuesday August 15th
All the 24 hours light bailing winds from
Northward and Eastward, Employed variously
finshed Bailing, cooping stowing oil
saw nothing but Ship and Land.

Wednesday August 16th
Commenced with a calm, Employed
stowing oil, middle and latter part calm
finshed stowing, 3 Boats off saw Whales to
no purpose.

Thursday August 17th
Commenced with light airs at S.E. Boats
off parted and killed one Whale at 2 P.M.
tripe anchor at 4 took the Whale a
long side drape anchor, middle and
latter part strong winds at S.W. at 11
AM commenced cutting at 10 finished 2 Boats
off.



Friday August 18th
Commenced with light winds at S.W. Employed
variously clearing up starting provisions
raising up the last lot of Shooks the last
we have looked for long time a gale, Boats
off, middle and latter part calm with bailing
saw no Whales, Employed Bailing

Saturday August 19th
Commenced with a calm Boats off, Employed
Bailing, middle and latter part bailing
saw several Whales to no purpose

Sunday August 20th
Commenced with light winds at S.W.
Boats off. Employed Bailing, saw nothing
middle and latter part bailing winds
with calms, finished Bailing Employed
cooping oil, no Whales in sight

Monday August 21st
Commenced with Calms Boats off. Employed
cooping oil, saw 2 Whales to no purpose
middle and latter part Calms with fog and
rain squalls, finished Bailing and commenced
stowing oil, 2 Boats off.

Tuesday August 22nd
Commenced with Calms fog and heavy looking
weather finished stowing oil, middle part
strong gale at N.E. with a hard rain storm
at 10 P.M. let go the Starboard anchor, latter
part calm with thick fog, hove up the Starboard
anchor, 2 Boats came from the Ship all the
day, saw nothing.
