

Saturday Sept 2nd
Commences with light winds at N. & Boats off
saw several Whales to no purpose, finished
stowing oil, Middle and Latter part
fresh breezes at N. & Boats off, trape anchor
to shift saw nothing but Ship Boats and Land

Sunday Sept 3rd
Commences with light hailing winds
at N. & at 5 P.M. dropped anchor saw Whales
to no purpose. Middle part calm Latter
light winds at W Boats off, saw nothing

Monday Sept 4th
Commences with light winds at W Boats
off, saw 2 Whales to no purpose. Middle part
calm. Latter part fresh breezes at W at 6 A.M.
took anchor to shift ground, saw several
Whales growing quick lower with cut success

Tuesday Sept 5th
Commences with strong winds at W.
Ship under way, nothing in sight but Ship
Boats and Land, middle and Latter part the
same, spoke Ship Republic Oyster 11 Whales

Wednesday Sept 6th
Commences with light winds at W Boats
off, nothing in sight, from the Ship, Boats saw
4 Whales growing quick, to no purpose, middle
part calm dropped anchor, Latter part light winds
at N. & with thick overcast, at daylight took
anchor made all sail headed S. & saw
nothing but Ship and Land

Thursday Sept 7th
Commences with light winds at S. & with thick
fog, employed scraping Boats, middle part
calm with fresh fog Latter part strong winds
at N. & Ship heading N. & to S. & S. & S. close
to the Land, 2 Ships in sight.

Friday Sept 8th
Commences with strong winds at N. & W.
steering S. along the Land, middle part under
short sail, Latter part strong gales at N. & W.
steered N. & to S. close to the Land, all pendant
sail set, thick fog and rain most of the time
at noon cleared up.

Saturday Sept 9th
Commences with strong winds at N. & W.
Ship heading S. by S. middle and Latter part light
winds at N. and pleasant steering S. & all sail
set 2 Ships in sight employed warily clearing
up stowing off, fresh breeze 20

Lat by obs 53.07. N. Long by Chron 145.23. E.

Sunday Sept 10th
Commences with light winds at N. & W.
pleasant steering S. & at 3 P.M. spoke Ship
Hessy Vantucket & Rucker 50 bbls, middle
and Latter part light winds at S. & W. Ship heading
S. & 2 Ships in sight

Lat by obs 52.18. N. Long by Chron 146.13. E.

Monday Sept 11th
Commences with light winds at N. & W. Ship heading
S. & the Hessy in company, saw 2 or 3 Whales turned
to no purpose. Middle and Latter part light
winds at N. & W. steering S. & all sail set
saw nothing employed in Ship duty
Lat by obs 51.38. N. Long 147.23. E.
