Tuesday

February the 14

this day commences with moderate gale and rugged weather from the W by N ship under close reef topsail and foresail heading N W by N at 8 A M wore ship heading S by W winds more moderate set whole topsails middle part wind N E steering W S W with all sail out latter part ricing so ends this day

Wednesday

February the 15

this day commences with strong gale and rugged weather from the S E ship under close reef topsail heading S W at 12 P M kept ten off steering N W set the fore sail fore and mizen topsails latter part more moderate set the mainsail jib and spanker so ends this day

Thursday

February the 16

this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant weather from the W ship under double reef topsails and courses heading N W W saw a sail middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Friday

February the 17

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S W ship under all sail steering N W by W broke out for water and bread middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Saturday

February 18

this day commences with strong gales and heavy squalls from the S W ship under close reef mizen topsail and foresail steering N W by N middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Sunday

February the 19

this day commences with strong gales and rugged weather from the S W ship under single reef topsails and courses steering N W by N middle and latter part the same so ends this day

February the 20 this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from the S W ship under all sail steering N W by W broke out for molasses middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday

February the 21 this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the W ship under all sail steering N W W carpenter employed in fitting a new boat latter part the same so ends this day

Wednesday

February the 22 this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S W ship under all sail steering N W W hands employed in ships duty painted the labboard and lower boats latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday

February the 23

this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship under all sail steering N W W hands employed in ships duty middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Friday

February the 24

this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship under all sail steering N W W hands employed in breaking out for water land of Marafuro in sight saw a sail latter part the same so ends this day

Saturday

February the 25

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship under all sail steering N W W hands employed in satling down spoke a spanish brig from calling bound to valparaiso latter part the same so ends this day

Sunday

February the 26

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S E ship under all sail steering N W latter part the same so ends this day
