so ends this day

wether from the S.E. ship under all sail steering N.E.
at 7 A.M. a boat went on shore to Nahor
after letters latter part returned kept of steering
N.W. so ends this day

Thursday April the 13
this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant
wether from the N.E. ship under all sail steering
W by N hands in sight and a number of sails
latter part the same so ends this day

Friday April the 14
this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant
wether from the N.E. ship under all sail steering
W by S hands employed in ship duty latter part the
same so ends this day

Saturday April the 15
this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant
wether from the N.E. ship under sail steering W
by S hands employed in ship duty latter part the
same so ends this day
