April the 22^d this day commences with lite breeze and pleasant wether from the N E ship under all sail steering W by S employed in ships duty the forenoon in site latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday

April the 23^d

this day commences with lite breeze and pleasant wether from the N E the ship under all sail steering W by S employed in ship duty at 11 A.M. spoke the ship Florida of New Bedford Captain Little & family on board and his wife and little girl came on board and spent the day latter part the same so ends this day

Wednesday

April the 24th

this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant wether from the E the ship under all sail steering W N W the Florida in site this morning the captain flogged 2 men put them in the stocks and gave them 14 lashes a piece at 4 A.M. spoke the Florida captain and his wife went on board and spent the day middle and latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday

April the 25th

this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant wether from the N E ship under all sail steering W N W at 2 P.M. wind shifted to N N W blowing a strong breeze took in lite sails and double reefed the topsails latter part moderate shook out the reefs and set the topgallantsails and flying jib ship heading W by N so ends this day

Friday

April the 26th

this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant wether from the N by E ship under all sail steering N W by W saw a sail middle and latter part the same so ends this day

April the 27th this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant wether from the N N E ship under all sail heading N W hands employed in ships duty saw a sail latter part the same saw pinbecks so ends this day

Sunday

April the 30

this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant wether from the E S E ship under all sail heading N N W middle and latter part the same so ends this day

MAY

Monday May the 1

this day commences with fresh breeze and thick wether from the E S E ship under all sail steering N N W middle part the same broke out for wether latter part rainy so ends this day

Tuesday

May the 2 this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant wether from the W ship under double reef topsails and foresail heading W N W middle part moderate shook out the reefs and set the maintopgallant sail and flying jib latter part the same so ends this day

Wednesday

May the 3 this day commences with a calm middle part lite breeze sprang up from the S W the ship steering W N W latter part the same so ends this day

Thursday

May the 4 this day commences with lite breeze and pleasant wether from the S S E the ship under all sail steering N N W middle part squally with rain from the E ship steering N latter part took in lite sails double reef the topsails took in the jib mainmast and spinnaker and the main topsail wind still blowing on so ends

Friday

May the 5 this day commences with strong gale and cloudy wether from the N N W ship under close reef maintopgallant heading N N E latter part more moderate shook out reefs out of the maintopgallant and set the foresail heading N so ends
