weather from the S S W ship under moderate sail
heading W saw a number of ships latter part
spoke the Florida of New Bedford 1 whale
Capt and wife were on board so ends this

June the 25

this day commences with lile breeze and pleasant
weather from the S S W ship under all sail head-
ding S E at 10 A M saw a dead whale lowered
the boats and took him to the ship
and cut him in latter part began
to try out saw a number of ships so ends this

this day commences with lile breeze and pleasant weather
from the N ship under moderate sail heading E N E
first part finished trying out rest part scraped the
bone spoke the ship Kingfisher & whales so ends this day

Thursday

June the 29

this day commences with lile breeze and pleasant weather
from the S S E ship under moderate sail heading
S W employed in storing down latter part finished
saw the land and 3 ships so ends this day

Friday

June the 30

this day commences with lile breeze and foggy weather
from the S S E ship under moderate sail heading
N E middle part the same latter part cleared off
spoke the Kingfisher saw the land so ends this day

JULY

Saturday the 1

this day commences with lile breeze and foggy weather
from the N W ship under moderate sail heading N
N E middle part the same, tacked ship a number of
times through the day latter part the same so ends this

Sunday

July the 2 this day commences with lile breeze and
foggy weather from the N N E ship under moder-
ate sail heading E spoke the Bonanza Capt. Spence
& 4 whales so ends this day
