this day commences with thick weather and a strong breeze ship at anchor broke out for meat and water latter part more moderate so ends this day

August the 23

this day commences with a fresh breeze took the anchor and stood to sea at 4 P.M. came to anchor sent a raft of ash ashore so ends this day

August the 24

this day commences with thick rainy weather went on shore after water middle part got along side of the ship hoisted it in latter part stowed it down the water still bad so ends this day

Sunday

August the 27

this day commences with lite breeze and foggy weather from the S.W. ship under all sail steering E by N latter part cleared up spoke the ship Matiscum Capt Woodbridge & whales so ends this day

Monday

August the 28

this day commences with fine breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship under all sail steering N.E. by E broke out for flour meat and cheese saw a sail latter part the same so ends this day

Tuesday

August the 29

this day commences with fine breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship under all sail steering N.E. by E employed in drying home latter part sailed the land bearing N.E. by N so ends this day

Wednesday

August the 30

this day commences with fine breeze and pleasant weather from the S.W. ship under all sail steering E by N employed in drying home broke out for bread latter part the same the land in sight bearing from E to W.S.W. so ends this day
