Thursday October the 26
This day commences with lite breeze and pleasant
weather from the S.W. ship under all sail
steering S. E. by E. hands employed in ships duty
broke out for water latter part wind from the
S.W. and fine weather so ends the day

Friday October the 27
This day commences with fresh breeze and ple-
asant weather from the N.W. ship under all sail
steering S. E. by E. hands employed in washing
bone middle part the same latter part wind
from the E. N. E. ship heading S. E. so ends the
day

Saturday October the 28
This day commences with strong breeze and pleasant
weather from S. by W. ship under all sail heading
S. E. by E. hands employed in washing and
drying bone latter part same broke out
for a barrel of meat and Molasses so ends the
day

Sunday October the 29
This day commences with strong breeze / mild
pleasant weather from the S. ship heading S. E. by E.
middle part wind from the S. W. heading S. E.
by E. hands employed in drying bone latter
part the same

Monday October the 30
This day commences with strong breeze and rainy
weather from the S. ship under double reef topsail
heading S. E. middle part heavy squalls with thun-
der and lightning latter part the same last
night spoke the Barque Rager of N. Bedford
Capt. Fisher 300 barrels so ends the day
broke out for a barrel
of meat

Tuesday October the 31

Thursday October the 31
This day commences with rainy weather and heavy
squalls from the Western ship heading to the south
ward under double reef main topsail and foresail
middle part strong breezes from the W. ship steering
S. latter part the same so ends the day of the
month

Friday November the 1
This day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant
weather from the N.W. ship under all sail steering
S. by E. spoke the ship *Samuel Robinson* Capt.
Marshall hands employed in bundling bone
latter part wind lit. so ends the day
broke out for water = Lat 25:27 N

Saturday November the 2
This day commences with light breeze and pleasant
weather from the N.W. ship steering S. by W. middle
part the same hands employed in bundling bone latter
part wind from N. ship steering S. by W. going 3 hrs
so ends the day

Sunday November the 3
This day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant
weather from the S. E. ship under all sail steering
S. W. hands employed washing ship & middle part
saw the Island of Maui saw a sail, latter part
finished washing ship got up the chains and
bent them so ends the day

Monday November the 4
This day commences with light breeze and
pleasant weather arrived in Maui
in the Sandwich Islands and came to
anchor on the 11 i was discharged
from the ship *Speedwell*
of Fairhaven Capt.
