sift of 22 pipes ashore for vent. Ends this
day in port.

Wednesday Oct. 31st 1855

Free hands employed in washing and bundling
bone. To ends this day in port.

Thursday November 1st 1853

All hands employed in bundling done, which is finished today. To end the day in port.

Friday November 2^d. 1855

At daylight took off the raft of water and hoisted it aboard. Bards employed in washing ships. To end this day in port.

Latania November the ~~25~~ 1855.

I was discharged from the ship
