Begins with fine breeze from the N^E
at 7 A.M. took the anchor at Maui
middle part fine latter part latter part
much the same laying off and on at Maui
so ends these 24 hours

Thursday 1st

Begins with fine weather ship laying off and
on at Maui middle and latter part
the same so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday 1st

Begins with strong winds from the N^E ship
laying off and on at Oahu middle part
fine latter part strong N^E winds
ship under double reef topsails so ends these 24

Saturday the 1st

Begins with strong winds from the N^E ship
under double reef topsails laying off and
at Oahu middle and latter part much the same
so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Sunday November 1st

Begins with fine pleasant weather with strong winds
from the N^E laying off on at Oahu with
ships in company middle and latter part
much the same so ends these 24 hours

Monday the 1st

Begins with fine weather with strong winds from
the N^E ship laying off and on at Oahu
at 3 P.M. captain came on board and took
our departure steering S by E middle and latter
part watch employed in getting the anchors

on the bows and rowing among the chains
so ends these 24

Remarks on board Tuesday the 1st

Begins with strong winds and squalls from the N^E ship
huddling E S E all sail set Mornere in company middle part
raining and baffling winds took in light sails latter part ship
under double reef topsails and fore sail huddling E S E
so ends these 24 hours

Wednesday the 20 and 21

Begins with strong winds and squalls from the
N^E ship huddling E S E under double reef topsails said
ship in company middle and latter part strong breezes from
the N^E heading S E by S ship under double reef topsails
so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Thursday November 22

Begins with strong winds from squalls from the N^E
huddling E S E under double reef topsails and fore sail
middle and latter part close reef fore topsail huddling E
by S watch employed in ship duty so ends these 24

Friday the 23

Begins with strong winds from the N^E heading
E S E under double reef topsails middle and latter part
huddling E S E under double reef topsails so ends these 24
hours

Remarks on board Saturday 1 November 24-1855

Begins strong breezes from the N^E heading S S E
under courses and double reef topsails watch employed
in ship duty middle and latter part set whole topsails
and maintop gallant sail watch employed in repair
ing sails so ends these 24 hours
