Sunday the 25th

Begins with strong winds from the N E steering
S E by S all sail set watch employed in ships
duty middle and latter part much the same so ends these
24 hours

Remarks on board Monday November 26 - 1855

Begins with strong breezes from the N E steering
S E by E under courses and double reef topsails
middle and latter part strong breeze with squalls of
rain from the N E heading S E watch employed
in breaking out water so ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 27th

Begins with rain and squalls from the N E steering
S E took in waist boat to mend ship under
single reef topsails middle and latter part fine
pleasant weather from the N E heading to Southward
watch employed in setting up rigging and mending boats
so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Wednesday 28th

Begins with light breeze and squalls of rain from
the N E reef heading S by E all sail set watch
employed in repairing rigging middle and latter part
fine breeze with rain so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Friday 29th

Begins with light breeze from the S E heading to
S S W all sail set watch employed in fitting
rigging and mending boats middle and latter part
fine weather from the S E heading S W all
sail set watch employed in mending boats
so ends these 24 hours

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Saturday 30th

Begins with fine weather from the S E heading S W
at 9 P.M. shift to the N E middle part shifted to the
S E latter part fine watch employed in painting
boats and other jobs so ends these 24 hours

Remarks on board Sunday December 1 and 2 - 1855

Begins with light breeze from the E S E heading S
all sail set watch employed in painting boats
middle part fine latter part light wind from the
E heading S all sail set so ends these 24 hours
Long by Chron 153-59
Lat by Obs 3-20.0

Monday 31st

Begins with smart breeze from the S E ship under
all sail watch employed ships but saw a fine breeze
middle and latter part much the same steering to the
Southward watch employed in fitting rigging
so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 5-35

Remarks on board Tuesday 4th 1855

Begins with fine weather and light breeze from the eastern
ship heading to Southward all sail set watch employ-
ed in ships duty middle and latter part much the
same so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 7-23

Wednesday 5th

Begins with fine weather ~~from~~ and light breeze
from the E ship steering S ship under all
sail watch employed in repairing rigging
middle and latter part much the same
so ends these 24 hours
Lat by Obs 8-11
