Remarks on Board Friday the 14

this day commences in port employed in getting of potatoes and securing middle and latter part in port
so ends this day

Saturday the 15

this day commences with being in port one watch ashore on liberty latter part wind light we took the anchor and stood to sea with a fine breeze from the Eastward
so ends this day

Sunday the 16

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the Eastward soon all hands employed in scurrying the cables saw blackfish lowered to logs and got two middle and latter part wind light ship heading N E so ends this day

Monday the 17

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N E ship heading N E saw blackfish middle part calm latter part light breeze from the Eastward ship heading N Captain and mate
so ends this day

Tuesday the 18

this day commences with fresh breeze and squally weather from the E S E ship heading N one sail in sight broke out water middle and latter part light breezes and squally so ends the
Lat by obs 33-49

Wednesday the 19

this day commences with fresh breeze and squally from the E ship heading N N E all sail one sail in sight off the starboard bow

middle part squally latter part strong breeze and squally weather from the E S E ship heading N E
so ends this day

Thursday the 20

this day commences with strong breeze and squally weather from the E ship heading N N E one sail in sight middle and latter part strong breeze and squally weather from the E S E ship heading N E under double reef topsail
so ends this day

Friday the 21

this day commences with strong breeze and squally weather from the E S E ship heading N E under double reef maintop sail and foresail one sail in sight latter part strong breeze and squally from the S E ship heading E S E hands employed in mending the maintop sail so ends this day
Lat by obs 31-48

Saturday the 22

this day commences with strong breeze and squally weather from the S E ship heading N E by E bent the maintop sail ship lashing two broke out one barrel of pork and one of beef middle and latter part moderate gale from the E S E ship heading N E so ends this day

Sunday the 23

this day commences with a moderate gale from the E S E ship heading N E under close reef maintop sail and foresail middle and latter part rugged weather from E S E ship laying two
Lat by obs 31-05

Monday the 24

this day commences with rugged weather from the E S E ship laying two under close reef maintop sail and foresail middle and latter part wind strong from the S E ship laying two under close reef maintop sail and reef foresail
so ends this day
