this day commences with strong breeze finished cutting in employed in boiling middle part laying two boiling latter part laying two ~~boiling~~ so ends this day

Monday the 21

this day commences with strong breeze employed in boiling and breaking out middle part laying two employed in boiling latter part light breeze employed in boiling

so ends this day

Tuesday the 22

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the N E ship laying two a boiling middle part laying two a boiling latter part light breeze a boiling the land in sight so ends this day

Wednesday the 23

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the E ship heading to the North stop boiling spoke to barque George Washington of New Bedford Capt. Conner 24 months 100 of sperm oil middle part light breeze latter part light breeze all hands employed in stowing down oil put down 65 barrels of oil

Thursday the 24

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the E ship heading N all sail set middle part laying two latter part light breeze and pleasant weather from the S W heading N W E ship with all sail set employed in stowing down oil Curtis rocks in sight bearing N N W

so ends this day

Friday the 25

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S W the ship heading N W E all sail set employed in stowing down oil and finished the rocks in sight one sail in sight middle part calm latter part light breeze from the S ship heading N E all sail set one sail in sight goat island in sight bearing S E so ends this day

Saturday the 26

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather from the S ship heading N E all sail set watch employed in stowing down meat goat island in sight one sail in sight middle part calm latter part strong breeze from the S W the ship heading E S E 2 sails in sight so ends this day

Sunday the 27

this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the S W the ship heading Widden double reef topsails 4 sails in sight shape the Barque Lafayette of N Bedford and the ship Lyon of Providence capt. Handwick 400 and capt. Allen 1500 middle part laying two latter part strong breeze 4 sails in sight saw sperm whale down boats but got nothing so ends this day
