 May Tuesday 13th 1856
 Begins strong gales from E & S & heaving
 on either tack by the wind doubling
 top sail set

Remarks on board Friday the 12th

this day commences with fresh breeze and
 squally weather from the S & S & ship heading
 on either tack. Gales and Sunday
 Island in sight one sail in sight middle
 part laying two latter part fresh breeze
 and pleasant weather from the S & S & the
 ship heading E by S watch employed
 to work in the rigging so ends this day

Tuesday the 13th

this day commences with fresh breeze
 and pleasant weather from the S & S &
 ship heading E by S watch employed
 to in sailing down the fore and main
 rigging middle part laying two latter part
 light breeze from the S & S & ship heading
 on either tack so ends this day

Wednesday the 14th

this day commences with strong breeze
 and squally weather from the S & S &
 the ship heading on either tack double
 reef top sails set started some water
 squiddle part laying two latter part light
 breeze from the S & S & ship heading on
 either tack so ends this day

Sat by obs 31-08

Thursday the 15th

this day commences with light breeze and
 some squally weather from the S & S &
 some squally weather from the S & S &
 on either tack watch
 employed to work in the rigging

Ship *Gloria of Sandy Island* Sailing

middle part laying two latter part
 a gale from the S & S & ship heading two
 heading to the S & S & watch employed
 to mend the mainsail Sat 30-57
 so ends this day

Friday the 16th

this day commences with a gale from
 the S & S & ship heading two heading
 S & S & watch employed in
 mending the mainsail top sail middle
 part laying two latter part strong gale
 from the S & S & kept on off steering
 S & S & split the main top sail and bent
 another so ends this day

Sat by obs 30-04

Saturday the 17th

this day commences with strong gales
 from the S & S & ship steering S & S
 bent a main top gallant sail and
 rose some new rigging middle part running
 S & S & latter part strong gale
 running S & S & bent a new fore top
 sail so ends this day

Sat by obs 28-38

Sunday the 18th

this day commences with a fresh gale
 from the S & S & ship steering S & S
 close reef top sails bent a new fore
 sail and a new gill and fore topmast
 stay sail middle part running S & S & latter part
 strong breeze from the S & S & ship steering
 S & S & under whole top sails
 and fore sail

so ends this day
