Thursday the 27th
this day commences with strong gales
and squally from the N^W ship steering
N^W by N under whole topsails and main
top gallant sail middle part lashing two
took in the main top sail latter part
sailing two it blowing strong so ends the
day by also 27-168

Wednesday the 28th
this day commences with strong gale from
the N^W by N set double reef fore and
main topsails and kept ship steering E^{SE}
middle part steering N^W by E latter part
strong breeze steering N^W by E all sail
set watch employed in clearing up the
deck so ends this day

Thursday the 29th
this day commences with strong breeze
from the N^W ship steering N^W by E
all sail set took in the Bow and
Waist boats middle part strong breeze
steering N^W by E latter part strong breeze
and squally ship steering N^W by E
all sail set so ends this day

Friday the 30th
this day commences with strong
breeze and heavy squalls from the N^W
ship steering N^W by E middle part strong
breeze and heavy squalls steering N^W by E latter
part the same ship steering N^W by E so
ends this day so ends by also 33-14

Saturday the 31st Long 168-50
this day commences with strong breeze
and squally weather from the N^W the
ship steering N^W single reef topsails set
and courses and gill

middle part fresh breeze and pleasant
weather from the N^W ship steering
N^W by E all sail set latter part strong breeze
from the N^W ship steering N^W by E the
fore topmast standing sail so ends this day
Lat by obs 35-02.8

June

this day commences with strong breeze
and good weather from the N^W ship
steering N^W by E all sail set
middle part strong breeze from the N^W
ship steering N^W by E latter part strong
breeze from the N^W ship heading N^W
so ends this day Lat by obs 37-53

Sunday the 2nd
this day commences with strong breeze
from the N^W ship heading N^W by E
double reef topsails set middle part
strong gale steering N^W by E latter part strong
gale from the N^W steering N^W by E
single reef topsails and top gallant sail
so ends this day Lat by obs 39-35

Monday the 3rd
this day commences with strong gales
from the N^W ship steering N^W by E
single topsails and top gallant sails
middle part strong breeze from the N^W
latter part light breeze from the N^W ship steering N^W
all sail set so ends this day
Lat by obs 41-06.8
