June Wednesday the 4
this day commences with light breeze and
squally weather from the W ship steering
E by S all sail set fore
top mast studding sail set middle part
fresh breeze from the W ship steering E by S
latter part the same so ends this day
Lat by obs 42-35

Thursday the 5 Long by obs 15-3-00
this day commences with strong breeze
and squally from the W ship steering E
by S broke out for water and meat
middle part strong breeze latter part
strong breeze and squally from the
W ship heading E by S all sail set
so ends this day Lat by obs 43-55

Friday the 6
this day commences with strong breeze and
squally weather from the W ship steering
E by S took in top gallant sails and
fore topmast studding sail middle part
strong breeze and heavy squalls from S by W
steering E latter part steering E by S
so ends this day Lat by obs 44-38

Saturday the 7
this day commences with strong breeze
and heavy squalls from the S by W the
ship steering E and double reef top sails
set middle part strong breeze and squally
from the S by W steering E by S latter
part strong breeze and squally from the
S by W ship steering E single reef top sails
set so ends this day
Lat by obs 42-47
Long by obs 140-30 West

Sunday the 8
this day commences with strong breeze and
squally from the S by W ship steering E by S
single reef top sails jib and mainmast
middle part strong breeze steering E by S
latter part strong breeze from the S by W steering
E by S all sail set so ends this day
Lat by obs 45-35

Monday the 9 Long by obs 18-0-00
this day commences with strong breeze and
squally weather from the W ship steering
E by S all sail set middle part fresh breeze
ship steering E by S latter part strong breeze
from the W ship steering E by S all
sail set so ends this day Lat by obs 47-03

Tuesday the 10
this day commences with strong breeze and
thick weather from the W ship steering
E by S all sail set middle and latter
part light breeze and thick weather from
the W ship steering E by S all sail set
broke out for bread and water so ends this day

Wednesday the 11
this day commences with fresh breeze
and some rain from the W ship steering
E by S all sail set broke out for
flour middle and latter part strong breeze
and thick from the W ship steering E by S
so ends this day

Thursday the 12
this day commences with strong breeze and
thick weather from the W ship steering E by S
fore topmast studding sail set middle and
latter part strong breeze from the W steering E
so ends this day Lat by obs 49-29
Long by obs 183-44
