 main sails latter part strong gale from

 and main sails sound this day

this day commences with more moderate weather

 under single reef topsails jib and main sail

this day commences with light breeze and
 pleasant weather from the W E ship heading
 S E all sail set broke out for meat

 latter part strong breeze from the S E
 ship heading E N E sound this day

 weather from the E N E ship heading N E
 all sail set middle and latter part light and
 baffling ship under all sail sound this day

 weather from the S W ship heading E by N
 all sail set broke out for butter
 middle and latter part strong breeze
 from the W ship steering E all sail set
 sound this day Lat by obs 54-55 W
 Long by obs 107 W

Friday the 20th

this day commences with strong breezes
 from the S W ship steering E all
 sail set middle and latter part strong
 gales from the W ship steering E
 by N double reef topsails set sound this day

Lat by obs 54-58 S

Saturday the 21st

this day commences with strong gales and
 rugged weather from the W ship steering E by N
 whole main topsail and double reef fore
 middle and latter part strong gales from
 the S W the ship steering E by N double
 reef topsails set sound this day

this day commences with strong gales from
 the S W ship steering E by N half N
 ship under double reef fore and main topsails
 and fore sail middle and latter part
 strong gales from the S W the
 ship heading E by N
