Monday the 23

this day commences with strong gales from the South steering E by N under close reefed top sail and main top sail and reef fore sail middle and latter part strong gales from the S ship steering East lost the Labard boat and split the fore topmast stay sail and stove the main boat so ends this day

Tuesday the 24

this day commences with strong gales from the S.W. ship steering E under close reefed top sail broke out mast and bread middle and latter part strong breeze from the S S.E. ship heading E by N all sail set so ends this day

Lat by obs 55-25 S
Long by obs 88-20 W

Wednesday the 25

this day commences with light breeze and good weather from the S.E. ship heading E by S all sail set middle part calm latter part light breeze from the N.W. ship steering E all sail set so ends this day

Lat by obs 56-05 S

Thursday the 26

this day commences with strong breeze and good weather from the N.W. ship heading E under all sail middle and latter part strong breeze from the N ship heading E by S double reef top sails set so ends this day

Friday the 27

this day commences with strong breeze from the N ship heading E by S double reef top sails set and courses set saw 2 ships one heading to the W and the Eastward

middle and latter part light breeze and huddling ship heading N.E. by E under short sail so ends this day

Saturday the 28

this day commences with light breeze and some snow from the S.E. ship heading N.E. by E under all sail middle and latter part light breeze and variable ship heading E.N.E. under all sail so ends this day

Long by obs 92-20 W

Sunday the 29

this day commences with light breeze and good weather from the West ship heading E.N.E. all sail set broke out some mast middle and latter part wind from the S.E. ship heading E.N.E. all sail saw a large Ice Range so ends this day

Monday the 30

this day commences with fresh breeze and good weather from S.E. ship heading E.N.E. all sail set middle part steering E.N.E. latter part light wind from the S.W. ship steering N.E. by N all sail set so ends this day

Tuesday the 1

this day commences with light breeze and pleasant weather and cold from the S ship steering N.W.E. under all sail and fore top mast studding sail saw a ship standing to the Westward middle part calm latter part strong breeze from the N.E. ship heading N.W. double reef top sails set so ends this day
