Saturday the 30

this day commences with fresh breeze and pleasant weather from the South the ship steering S by W all sail set save one sail middle and latter part light breeze from the N W the ship steering S by W all sail set saw 2 sails 20 miles there 24 hours Lat by obs 35° 23' 30" Long by obs 71° 10' 40"

Sunday the 31

this day commences with strong breeze and pleasant weather from the S W ship heading W N W took in top gallant sails and fly jib rounded the Barge B, C Hamilton of Portland middle and latter part light breeze and freshening ship N E and W N W Lat by obs 39° 02'

September Monday the 1 September the 1

this day commences with a calm went in board of the Brig Aurora of Boston our ship lying in a calm within 130 miles of Block Island middle part calm latter part fresh breeze from the N E ship heading N by E

Tuesday the 2

this day commences with strong and good weather from the N E ship heading N W E saw a New York pilot boat middle and latter part strong breeze ship heading in from the land at 6 P.M. made the land Montauk Point lost ship and stood off

this day commences with strong breeze and rugged weather from the N E ship heading up shore saw plenty of ships Bound to New York middle and latter part light breeze from the N E
