 Moderate breeze from E. all sail set
 steering by the wind S. E. & all hands
 employed in ship's duty, and there is not
 any man who is sea sick, and
 what is not sea sick, is home sick, as for me,
 I was most dreadful home sick this morning
 if I could have got home I would have gone
 if the whole world had have laughed at
 me.
 Latitude 38° 18' North,
 Longitude 69° 38' West.

Friday Sept 4th
 Strong breeze from East all sail set steering
 by the wind S. E. & at 2 P.M. took in fore
 and main top gallant sails, most all sea sick,
 and I am home sick.
 Middle and latter part the same, employed
 filling boats this ends.
 Latitude 38° 15' North
 Longitude 67° 25' West.

Saturday Sept 5th
 Fresh breeze from East all sail set steering by
 the wind S. E. & at 6 P.M. took in fore & main
 Middle and latter part the light wind,
 all hands employed in ship's duty this ends,
 and it seems as though we had been from
 home, A month, hard, hard, hard.
 Latitude 37° 08' North
 Longitude 66° 38' West.

Sunday Sept 6th
 Light breeze from East all sail set steering
 by the wind S. E. & all hands
 employed in ship's duty, and there is not
 any man who is sea sick, and
 what is not sea sick, is home sick, as for me,
 I was most dreadful home sick this morning
 if I could have got home I would have gone
 if the whole world had have laughed at
 me.
 Latitude 37° 55' North
 Longitude 64° 21' West.

Monday Sept 7th
 Light breeze from West all sail set steering
 East - Middle part the same, - latter part
 wind some backing and squally all hands employed
 in ship's duty, this ends, home sick.

Tuesday Sept 8th
 Wind light and backing, until 2 P.M. then strong
 breeze and rain from N.W. & handed light sail
 at 4 wind increasing double reefed the top sails
 and handed jib and main sail at 6 closed reefed
 the main top sail, and took in the fore, I wish
 I was at home. - Middle part fresh gale,
 latter part strong breeze from North, at 6 P.M.
 set double reefed top sails, course E. & S. this ship
 is rather wet & soiled but not in one side than
 the other, about all you can do is to stand and
 hold on, many of the old clippers would do
 much better.
 Latitude 38° 31' North.
