

Friday Nov 6th

Strong breeze and cloudy from E. & E. all day, set strong W. & W. & W. Middle part wind from N. & N. & N. and fresh, latter part strong breeze with rain from North, at 9 A.M. hauled light sails and could not see the top sails, thus ends, a stormy dull and long some day.

Saturday Nov 7th

Strong breeze with much rain from North ship under double reef top sails courses and jib, steering W. by N. at 4 P.M. good weather set all sail, Middle part fresh breeze, from N. & N. & N. Latter part strong breeze and rugged, at 11 A.M. wind shifted more ship to W. & W. broke out fresh water keel and masts, took in the B. boat and mended her, and put her out again, thus ends.

Sunday Nov 8th

Strong breeze and rugged from West all sail set steering by the wind W. & W. & W. Middle part the same, Latter part more moderate set all sail steered by the wind W. by N. & N. thus ends.

Monday Nov 10th

Fresh breeze from N. & N. & N. all sail set steering by the wind W. & W. & W. Middle part light wind calm some of the time Latter part light breeze from N. & N. & N. set heading S. by E. slowed the air between decks, at 10 P.M. saw a lone whale lowered the boats chased him five hours then gave it up for a bad job, thus ends.

Tuesday Nov 11th

Moderate breeze and pleasant weather from W. & W. & W. all sail set steering by the wind W. & W. & W. Middle and Latter part pleasant weather, heading by the wind W. & W. thus ends.

Latitude 32° 15' South,
Longitude 31° 57' West.

Wednesday Nov 12th

Moderate breeze and pleasant weather from W. & W. & W. all sail set steering by the wind W. & W. & W. at 5:30 P.M. saw sperm whale going almost railroad speed, about 10 A.M. lowered the boats could not come up with them, at dark came on board, Middle and Latter part much the same, thus ends.

Thursday Nov 13th

Light air and pleasant weather from S. & S. ship head W. & W. at 4 P.M. saw sperm whales, lowered the boats struck about 5:30 in striking second boat got stove when the whale turned up went to look for the sign boat but it was too dark to find her, got the whale to the ship at 10 P.M. Middle and Latter part fair weather at day light called all hands commenced cutting finished at 10 A.M. wind W. & W. ship heading W. & W. saw two sail, thus ends.
