

Wednesday Dec 11th 1857

Fresh breeze from WNW all sail set
steering Southwesterly at 12 P.M. hauling on
main and light sails, at 6 more ship to S.W.
at dark, took in sail to close reefed main
top sail.

Middle and Latter part strong breeze
at 5 A.M. set double reefed top sails, steered
by the wind S.W. at noon wore ship to
N.W. thus ends.

Thursday Dec 12th

Strong breeze and cloudy from WNW ship under
double reefed top sails head N.W. at 2 P.M.
squally rainy weather took in sail to double
reef main top sail.

Middle and Latter part fresh breeze and clear
weather from S.W. at 4 A.M. made sail subtle
to the weather, at 7 more ship to S.E. thus ends.

Latitude $46^{\circ} 08'$ South,
Longitude $57^{\circ} 20'$ West,

Friday Dec 13th

Fresh breeze and clear weather from WNW ship
under easy sail steering down coast at dark
took in sail and heeled by the wind WNW.

Middle and Latter part pleasant weather at
sunrise set all sail steered Southwesterly,
saw a number of pinbacks, without the
jelly repaired and bent it again,
thus ends.

Latitude $45^{\circ} 47'$ South,
Longitude $56^{\circ} 30'$ West,

Saturday Dec 14th 1857

Fresh breeze from WNW, steered by the wind
S.W. at dark shortened sail,

Middle part the same.

Latter part, rain and thunder in the morning
at 8 A.M. cleared off made sail at 10 P.M. at
an sudden clewed up and clewed down to
double reefed main top sail, at noon closed
reef the main top sail, thus ends.

Latitude $46^{\circ} 25'$ South,

Sunday Dec 15th

Fresh gale and clear weather from WNW,
ship have two head WNW.

Middle part more moderate.

Latter part rather better got double reefed top
sails courses and jib, are heeled in the course
of the forenoon, wind West ship head East.

Latitude $45^{\circ} 20'$ South,
Longitude $56^{\circ} 17'$ West,

Monday Dec 16th

Fresh breeze from WNW at 1 P.M. got all
sail set steered by the wind East, at sun
down tacked to S.W. and shortened sail.

Middle and Latter part fresh breeze, at 5 P.M. set
double reefed top sails, at 11 more ship to WNW, tacked to WNW.

Latitude $45^{\circ} 25'$ South,
Longitude $56^{\circ} 18'$ West,

Tuesday Dec 17th

Fresh breeze but inclining to moderate from WNW
ship under easy sail, steering by the wind WNW
at sun down shortened sail.

Middle part light airs, Latter part at 7 P.M. breeze
from WNW steered S.W. under all sail, reached
the margin top sail mended it and sent it again.
