

Monday Jan 18th 1858

Fresh breeze and clear weather from East all
sail set steering N. S. W. at 7 P.M. hauled
main reef and mizen S. G. Sail,
middle part fresh breeze, wither looking dirty.
double reef the S. sail, and S. S. E.
Latter part more moderate at 10 set all sail
saw a sail steering Eastward, thus ends,
Latitude 56° 47' South,
Longitude 75° 20' West.

Tuesday Jan 19th

Light breeze and clear weather from E. S. E. all
sail set steering N. S. W.
Middle part wind E. S. E. and fresh some time
Latter part strong breeze from N. E. at
10. Squall from W. W. then wind N. E. again,
thus ends.

Latitude 56° 48' South,
Longitude 79° 06' West.

Wednesday Jan 20th

Strong breeze and cloudy from N. E. all
sail set steering N. S. W. at 7 P.M. blowing
on hauled S. G. Sail double reef the top
sails, hauled jib and main sail at 6
hauled fore and mizen top sail last reef the
main, at 7 hauled fore sail and hove
too head W. W. W. main
middle part, at 11 P.M. wind quite moderate
Latter part moderate from West, more ship to
W. W. W. made some sail, thick fog, at 11 P.M.
blow up from S. W. very quick took in sail
to double reef main top sail, thus ends.

Latitude 56° 05' South,
Longitude 80° 26' West.

Thursday Jan 21st 1858

Fresh gale from S. W. ship head W. W. W. at 7
P.M. last reef the main top sail, at 8
fore sail reef,
middle part more moderate set double reef
sails jib and main sail,
Latter part moderate from West inclining
W. W. W. all sail set steering by the wind
and W. W. W. at noon, distant to W. S. W.
thus ends Latitude 54° 50' South.

Friday Jan 22nd

Fresh breeze and cloudy from N. W. W. all sail
set steering by the wind West, at 2 P.M.
hauled S. G. Sail, at 3 wind North fresh and
rain double reef the S. sail, hauled jib
and main sail, at 4 fresh gale with rain
hauled fore sail, fore top sail, and last reef
the main
middle part much the same - Latter part
more moderate, and thick wither, but the Barometer
low 28.60 at 8 set fore sail reef, at noon wore ship
to W. W. W. set S. G. Sail last reef, thus ends.

Saturday Jan 23rd

Strong breeze and cloudy from West ship under two
last reef S. sail, and reef fore sail head W. W. W. at
1 P.M. one reef, and S. G. Sail, set jib and mizen S. sail
at 2:30 wind W. S. W. and blowing on two in sail
to last reef all S. sail, at 4 blowing a perfect gale
with rather a bad sea, turned up the S. Boat, the Barometer
28.60 but rather inclined up - Middle part fresh gale
Latter part more moderate set fore S. sail and
fore sail reef, at 7 P.M. set jib and mizen
top sail, at 10 set main sail, saw a sail steering
Eastward, wind W. S. W. course of ship
W. S. W. thus ends.

Latitude 56° 12' South,
Longitude 80° 40' West.
