

Monday April 9th 1858

Squally day wither from the West, all sail set heading Westward, the Vigant in sight, at 4 P.M. strong breeze and rugged from N.E. hauled light sails, Middle part fresh breeze and clear, Latter part not much wind but a heavy swell with rainy bad wether, ship under easy sail, steering W.N.W. this ends,

Saturday April 10th

Fresh breeze from E.S.E. and a heavy swell from W.E. with frequent squalls of rain, ship under easy sail steering W.N.W. at dusk double reefed the top sails, hauled jib and main sail, Middle part wind backing with much rain, Latter part wind S.E. with rain at 10 P.M. wind South, and rain held up, steering W.N.W. this ends,

Latitude 26° 20' North,
Longitude 174° 30' East,

Sunday April 11th

Fresh breeze and rugged from South ship under double reef top sail steering W.N.W. Middle part heavy showers of rain, Latter part moderate breeze from West head by the wind N.W. this ends, I shall now change the day for East Longitude,

Latitude 28° 04' North,
Longitude 173° 23' East,

Tuesday April 13th 1858

Moderate breeze and haze from N.W. all needful sail set steering by the wind, Middle part the same, Latter part, unless the mizen top sail to mend, at 9 P.M. come up thick and rainy, this ends,

Wednesday April 14th

Moderate breeze and thick drizzly wether from West all sail set steering by the wind, N.W. broke out the fore hole for water, at 2 P.M. cleared off, finished and bent the mizen top sail, Middle and Latter parts light breeze and pleasant wether from the same point, Middle part, this ends,

Latitude 31° 48' North,
Longitude 172° 38' East,

Thursday April 15th

Light wind from West all sail set heading N.W. sent down the main royal yard, unless the spanker and bent the close mizen, at 5 P.M. light wind from S.E. could not W.N.W. Middle part fresh breeze - Latter part strong breeze by 10 P.M. had in sail to double reef top sail, much rain, at 10 wind shifted to S.W. in a squall hauled fore and mizen top sails at 11 clear wether set fore and mizen top sails, if a man has got \$10000 what he will go walking for, and leave their pretty mine at home, Ill. bet I would not do so, this ends,

Latitude 33° 32' North,
