

Wednesday April 16th 1858

Strong breeze from S.W. ship under double
reef top sails steering W by N at 4 P.M.
blowing on hander mizen top sail, at
6:30 hauled fore top sail and last
reef the main.
Middle part moderate some of the time
Latter part strong gale at 8 P.M. hauled fore
sail wind shifted, at 11 we ship to W.W.
Latitude 34° 53' North,

Thursday April 17th

Strong breeze from W.W. ship head West
at 2 P.M. set fore sail and let out
reef out of the main top sail at 4 set S.S.
sail, at 6 set mizen top sail.
Middle part light wind.
Latter part light air and pleasant weather
all sail set head W.W. unbraced the fore top
sail and bent another, broke out the slops
and supplied the men with clothing, this evening
Latitude 35° 02' North,

Friday April 18th

Calms, Middle part moderate breeze
from N.E. course W by N.

Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy this evening

Saturday April 19th

Fresh breeze from East all sail set course
W by N at 2 P.M. hauled light sails
at 4 bringing on with rain, at 6 double
reef the top sails.

Middle part fresh gale, at 8 closed reef the M.S.
sail, and hauled the fore

Latter part strong gale with much rain
at 9 P.M. hauled the fore sail and
have the ship too head W by E, this evening
chilly bad weather - M.A.M.

Sunday April 20th 1858

Strong gale and cloudy from S.E. ship
have too head W by E, at 1:30 P.M. we
ship to S.E.

Middle part the same,

Latter part more moderate at
5 P.M. we ship to N.W. and set fore
sail, at 6:30 heaved off W.W. at 10 P.M.
had double reef top sails, this evening

Monday April 21st

Strong breeze and cloudy from East
ship under double reef top sails steering
W by N

Middle part the same,

Latter part more moderate let the reef
out the top sail, saw five backs, employed
mending the fore top sail, this evening

Latitude 43° 41' North
Longitude 166° 42' East,

Tuesday April 22nd

Fresh breeze and hazy from East ship
under easy sail steering W by N, at 6:30
P.M. double reef the top sails.
Middle part about the same hauled jib and
mizen top sail. Latter part strong wind
and thick rainy weather from S.E. at noon took
in fore top sail, this evening

Wednesday April 23rd

Strong wind from S.E. ship under double reef
M.S. sail, and fore sail steering W by N

Middle and Latter part more moderate,

at 10 A.M. set fore and mizen top sails
and jib thick fog, I wish I was worth
\$10,000 and at home, I would see if I
could not find some snug little woman that
would be willing to share my bed and house,
