

Sunday Sept 12th 1858,

Fresh breeze and clear from N.E. all sail set
steering S.E.

Middle and Latter part light wind and pleasant
weather from N.W. all sail set steering S.E. by E,
thus ends, I am lonesome, no one to have
so call chat with, I have been at sea some
time but never have been where things goes
as they do here, Clipper fashion may be,

Latitude 51° 05' North,
Longitude 172° 16' East,

Monday Sept 13th

Light wind and fine weather from N.W. all sail
set steering S.E. by E,

Middle and Latter part the same,

Latter part moderate breeze from South,
all sail set steering E.S.E. sent down the
cutting blocks, and cleared up a little about,
thus ends,

Latitude 50° 10' North,
Longitude 171° 40' East,

Tuesday Sept 14th

Moderate breeze and cloudy from South all
sail set steering E.S. by S,

Middle and Latter part the same, thus ends,

Latitude 49° 05' North,
Longitude 178° 43' East,

Wednesday Sept 15th

Light wind and pleasant weather from South all
sail set steering E.S.E.

Middle and Latter part the same,
unbent the fly jib to mend, thus ends,
another day of troubles,

Latitude 47° 55' North,
Longitude 178° 00' West,

Thursday Sept 16th 1858,

Light wind and cloudy from S.E. all sail
set steering by the wind E.S.E. finished
and bent the fly jib unbent the mizen
and bent the spanker,

Middle and Latter part much the same,
waited employed fudding and odd jobs, thus ends,

Friday Sept 17th

Moderate breeze and cloudy from S.E. all
sail set steering by the wind E.S.E. tail E,
middle part fresh breeze and flowing at S.
E. by N. hauled light sails,

Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy from
the same point, set all S.E. sail, and fly
jib, at 8 tagged to S.W. thus ends,

Latitude 48° 16' North,
Longitude 176° 30' West,

Saturday Sept 18th

Fresh breeze and cloudy from S.E. all sail
set steering by the wind S.S.W. at 2 P.M.
tacked to E.S.E.

Middle part wind from N.E. course S.E. by E,
Latter part fresh breeze and cloudy with
a heavy head swell, at noon had to take in
the small sail, thus ends,

Sunday Sept 19th

Strong breeze and cloudy from N.E. and a heavy
head swell, prudent sail set steering S.E. by E,
at 4 P.M. double reefed the top sails,
middle part more moderate and not so much
swell,

Latter part decent weather, set all sail well
N.W. course S.E. by E, thus ends,
Latitude 45° 12' North,
